## Overlea Boulevard Bridge over West Don River Interim Repair

**Contract: 21ECS-TI-15BE**  
**Start Date: August 2021 End Date: November 2021**  
*\*Timeline is subject to change.*

The City of Toronto is planning to perform an interim deck repair on the Overlea Boulevard Bridge (also known as Charles H. Hiscott Bridge) over the West Don River. This work will involve repairs on the deck and sidewalks to ensure that the bridge remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians.

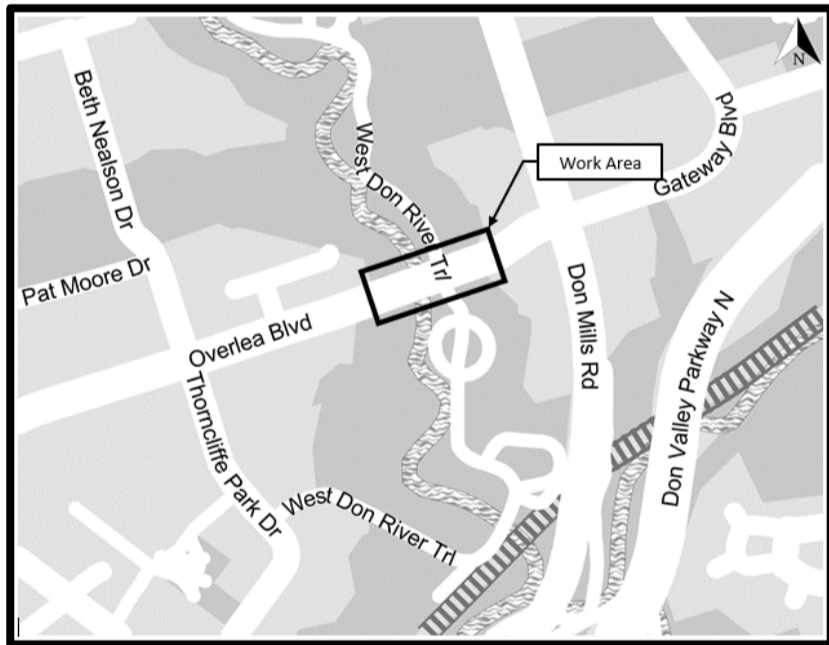
While planning for the long-term bridge superstructure replacement project is underway, this project is not related to the long-term replacement. The work is necessary to ensure the bridge remains safe until the long-term replacement can be completed.

The interim repair project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program.

### WHAT TO EXPECT BEFORE CONSTRUCTION

- Work crews will mark the locations of underground utilities, such as gas, water and cable so that the construction work does not interfere with these utilities.
- The construction work will take place outside of rush hours and there will be temporary lane and sidewalk closures within the work zone. No construction work will be conducted during rush hours.
- Affected properties will receive a Construction Notice approximately two weeks before work begins with more information about the work.

	<p><b>Accessible Accommodation:</b> Residents who require accommodation (level entry, longer notice, etc.) must contact the <b>Project Manager</b> to arrange for access during the construction period.</p>
	<p><b>Tree Removal:</b> Due to the nature of this project, the City will have to remove trees from the project area along Overlea Boulevard. Trees in the removal area will be replaced.</p>



**Parks and Trails:** Due to the nature of this work, a section of the West Don River Trail will be affected. Temporary construction fence and overhead protection will be installed to ensure the public's safety. Signs will be posted. All areas affected by construction will be restored.
