Congregate Living Setting Resources Toolkit

This document provides an overview of resources for those working on COVID-19 prevention and response in congregate living settings (e.g., shelters, group homes, supportive housing).

Congregate Living Setting Resources

COVID-19 Preparedness and Prevention in Congregate Living Settings (Public Health Ontario): This checklist can be used by administrators and staff members in a range of congregate living settings to help plan for, prevent and detect COVID-19. (Measures include use of personal protective equipment, ventilation of indoor spaces and other infection prevention and control measures. Ensure that your HVAC system is regularly assessed by professionals designated in HVAC cleaning, maintenance and repair to ensure safe and appropriate ventilation for your specific setting).

Managing COVID-19 Outbreaks in Congregate Living Settings (Public Health Ontario):

This checklist can be used by congregate living setting administrators and staff members and local public health unit staff members when there is an outbreak or possible outbreak in a congregate living setting.

<u>COVID-19: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Non-Medical Masks in Congregate Living</u> <u>Settings</u> (Public Health Ontario):

This document is intended to provide administrators and staff with information on personal protective equipment (PPE) and masks to prevent the spread of infection (source control) in congregate living settings. It provides information on what PPE staff members and residents should wear when there is an outbreak of COVID-19 in the facility and when there is not.

<u>Cohorting during an Outbreak of COVID-19 in a Congregate Living Setting</u> (Public Health Ontario):

This webinar from July 21, 2020 will review the principles of cohorting of clients and staff during a COVID-19 outbreak in a congregate living setting.

<u>COVID-19: Cohorting in Outbreaks in Congregate Living Settings</u> (Public Health Ontario):

This is a detailed document on cohorting intended for public health units to use when assisting congregate living settings in establishing and working in cohorts during a COVID-19 outbreak.

This tip sheet is designed to help homelessness service providers strategize for isolation in place and cohorting clients and staff within the shelter.

It reviews general information of the risk of COVID-19 in these settings, preparedness steps, physical distancing, and infection prevention and control principles, including the use of personal protective equipment.

IPAC For Extenders (Public Health Ontario):

This webinar from December 15, 2020 discusses the basics of screening, cohorting, distancing and cleaning/disinfecting in congregate settings.

This resource is designed for infection prevention and control (IPAC) leads at congregate settings, such as shelters and group homes, to assist them with providing reminders of key IPAC information at shift-change meetings or huddles, especially for new employees.
