Port Union Road Improvements Lawrence Avenue East to Island Road

The City of Toronto will present the design of the Port Union Road widening, from Lawrence Avenue East to Island Road. Once complete, this project will improve conditions for people walking, cycling, and driving, and better manage traffic flow. The City invites you to learn more about the details of the upcoming improvements, see details on page 2.

In Summer 2021, Enbridge Gas is scheduled to complete utility relocations associated with their gas main. Road construction is tentatively scheduled to begin after the utility relocations in late 2021. A pre-construction notice will be mailed out to residents and businesses before road construction begins.

What do these changes mean for you?

Pedestrian Improvements

- Sidewalks on both sides of the street
- Accessible pedestrian crossings with tactile plates

Cycling Improvements

- Bicycle lanes on both sides of the street
- Builds connections to the local existing and planned cycling network

Vehicular Traffic Changes

- Addition of a second northbound lane
- Centre-turn lanes at key locations
- Traffic signal updates
- Improved entrances to properties

Sustainability/Green Features

- Grass and landscaped boulevards
- Planting of new trees along the boulevard

Virtual Public Meeting
