## How to Get Your First or Second Dose

There are many ways that people who are homeless can receive the vaccine. There is no wrong pathway to get your vaccine!

You do not need a health card to access the vaccine through these pathways.

### Attend a Clinic at a Shelter or 24-Hour Respite Site

Ask shelter or respite staff about the next clinic where you are staying.

---

### Walk into City Immunization Clinic

Walk-in vaccinations are available at City-run clinics ([www.toronto.ca/COVID19vaccine](http://www.toronto.ca/COVID19vaccine)) Tuesdays to Saturdays from 1 p.m. to 7 p.m.

---

### Book an Appointment

Book an appointment through the provincial booking system ([www.covid-19.ontario.ca](http://www.covid-19.ontario.ca)).
