Rapid Antigen Screening Flow Chart Shelter, Support and Housing Administration Current as of September 9, 2021

Purpose

This flow chart provides an overview of the administration of Rapid Antigen Screening for new client admissions to Shelter, Hotel and other overnight programs.

Client attends program for admission. Intake/Admission staff verify there are no safety alerts on the client page. If safety alerts are found, follow listed instructions. Client is screened for COVID-19 using the COVID-19 Client Screening Tool.

Client does not have any COVID-19 symptoms. Client has COVID-19 symptoms or has been in contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19. Staff explain Rapid Antigen Screening to the client. Client is referred to a COVID-19 Assessment Centre for PCR testing. Individuals previously diagnosed with and cleared of COVID-19 infection 90 days from the date of their -ENDpositive COVID-19 result or fully vaccinated individuals (i.e. ≥14 days after receiving their second dose of a two-dose COVID-19 vaccine series or their first dose of a one-dose COVID-19 vaccine series), will not require Rapid Antigen Screening. Client has not tested positive for COVID-19 in the past Client has tested positive for COVID-19 and has been cleared of COVID infection 90 days or client is not fully vaccinated. 90 from the date of positive results or client is fully vaccinated.
