1. **Ahmed Ejaz Khan** (Report No. 7411)
Holder of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-4988353

DECISION:

The Tribunal revoked Mr. Khan's Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-4988353

The Tribunal proceeded with a hearing on this matter ex parte, at the request of Municipal Licensing and Standards.

2. **Hasseeb Ahmad** (Report No. 7602)
Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence (Application No. C045453)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

"Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence be issued subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licences may be cancelled;
- (2) The Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for **Three (3)** years. Hasseeb Ahmad is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Hasseeb Ahmad and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Hasseeb Ahmad's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (3) Prior to the next renewal, Hasseeb Ahmad must submit, to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards, proof of completion of an Anger Management Course with the Toronto Salvation Army;
- (4) Prior to each of the next **Three (3)** renewal(s) of the licence, Hasseeb Ahmad must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Hasseeb Ahmad or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7602 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
