**DECISION:**

- 2. Humber Taxi Inc.** (Report No. 7601)

Applicant for the Renewal of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-3114418, V02-3114419, V02-3114422 and V02-3114423; Plate Nos. 123, 448, 649 and 768

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on June 2 and June 3, 2021, as follows:

"Taxicab Owner's Licences will be renewed subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 90 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licences may be cancelled;

The Tribunal ordered an amendment to condition 2, on consent:

- (2) The **Taxicab Owner's Licences** will be placed on probation for a period of One (1) year. Humber Taxi Inc. is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Humber Taxi Inc. and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Humber Taxi Inc.'s compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Humber Taxi Inc. or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7601 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
