TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL ELECTRONIC HEARING: May 20, 2021 (9:30 AM) Summary of Decisions A. Bakshi / V. Francis / D. Simon

1. Ahmed Raza (Report No. 7467) Holder of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4969616

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on May 17 and May 18, 2021, as follows:

"Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4969616 will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements (except for those specified under conditions 4 and 5, below) must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application/licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being renewed, the Licence shall be suspended until 11:59 PM on June 24, 2021;
- (3) Immediately upon being renewed, the Licence shall be placed on probation for a period of four (4) years. Ahmed Raza is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against him and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Ahmed Raza's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 546 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;"

The Tribunal ordered an amendment to condition 4, on consent:

(4) Ahmed Raza must submit proof to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards of his successful completion of the Back on Track remedial measures program, or equivalent, and payment of any outstanding fines imposed as part of the June 24, 2020 conviction for careless driving, on or before July 30, 2021, failing which the Licence may be cancelled;

- (5) "Prior to each of the next four (4) renewals of the licence, Ahmed Raza must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check; and,
- (6) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Ahmed Raza or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7467 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
