

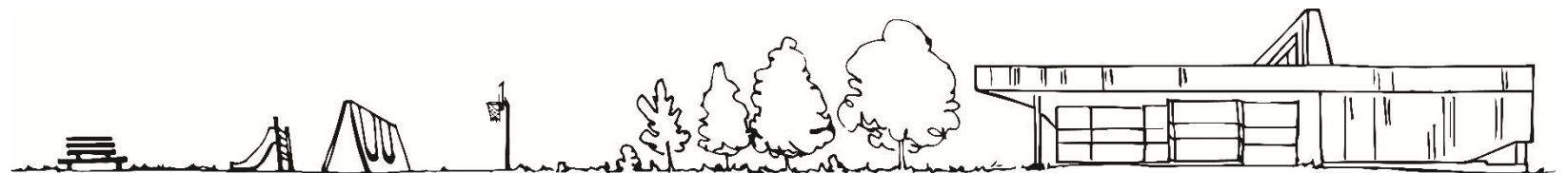

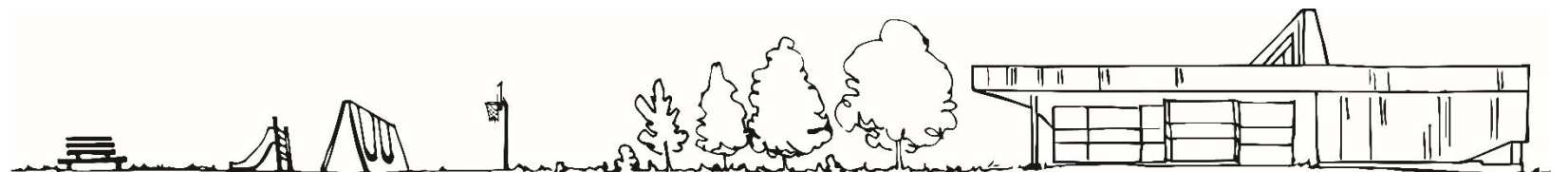

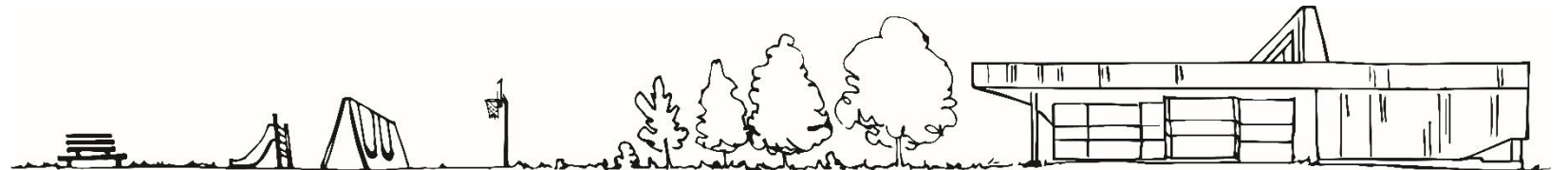

# Project Overview

The City is updating the Dieppe Park **Family Play Zone** and creating a Dieppe **Park Improvement Plan** to guide future park improvements.



# Family Play Zone Updates

The Family Play Zone updates will include:

- A new playground
- A new splashpad
- Improved seating and pathways





# Park Improvement Plan

The Park Improvement Plan will identify and prioritize future park improvement projects to undertake as funding becomes available.

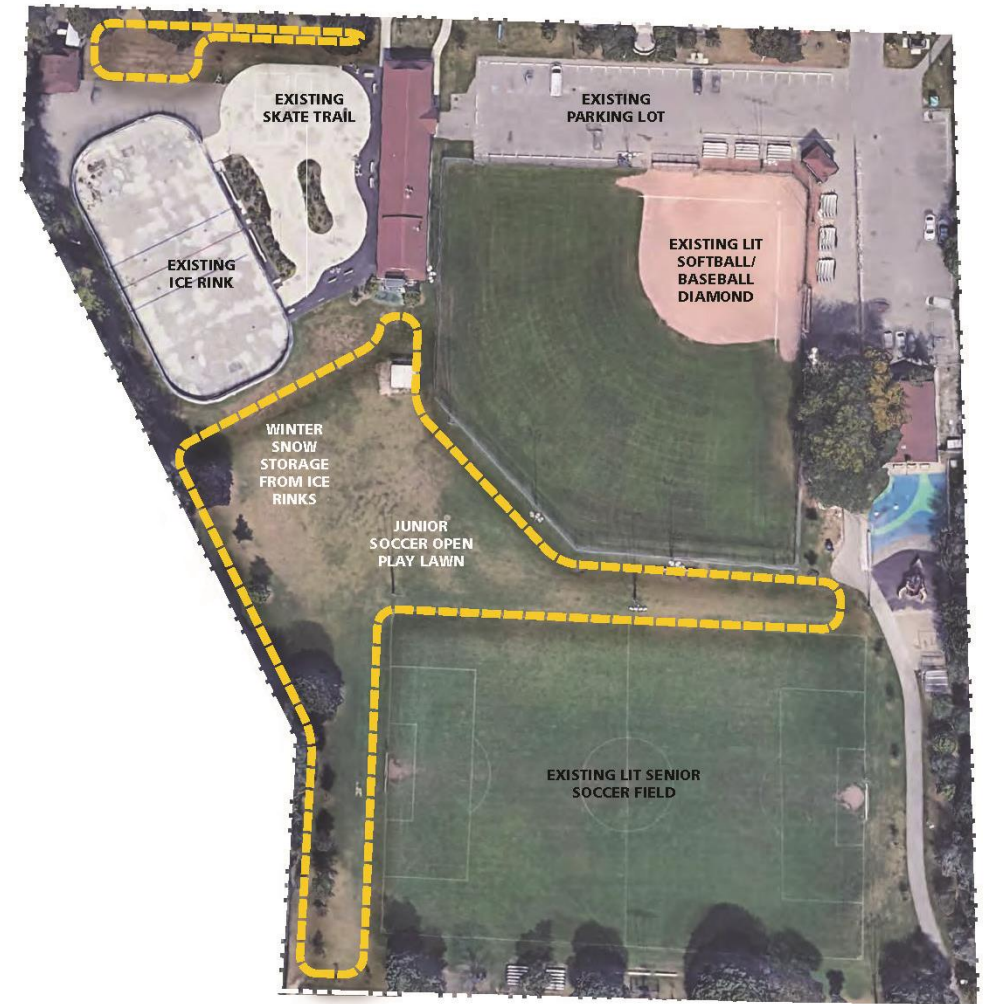
**The Improvement Plan will not include the removal or relocation of any existing recreational spaces.**



# Park Improvement Plan

The Improvement Plan will influence:

- Use of the space between the existing ice rink and soccer field as a zone for new, non-permitted uses.
- Circulation and pathways through the park.
- The potential creation, location and design of a new fitness zone.
- Opportunities to enhance existing recreation spaces.

Construction of the new playground/water play area.

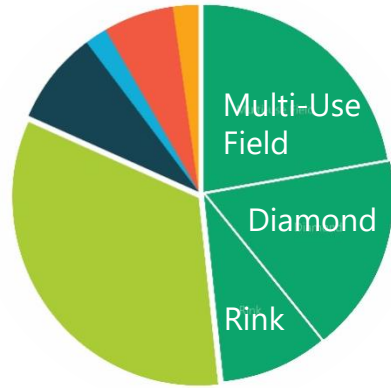

# Park Context and Existing Assets



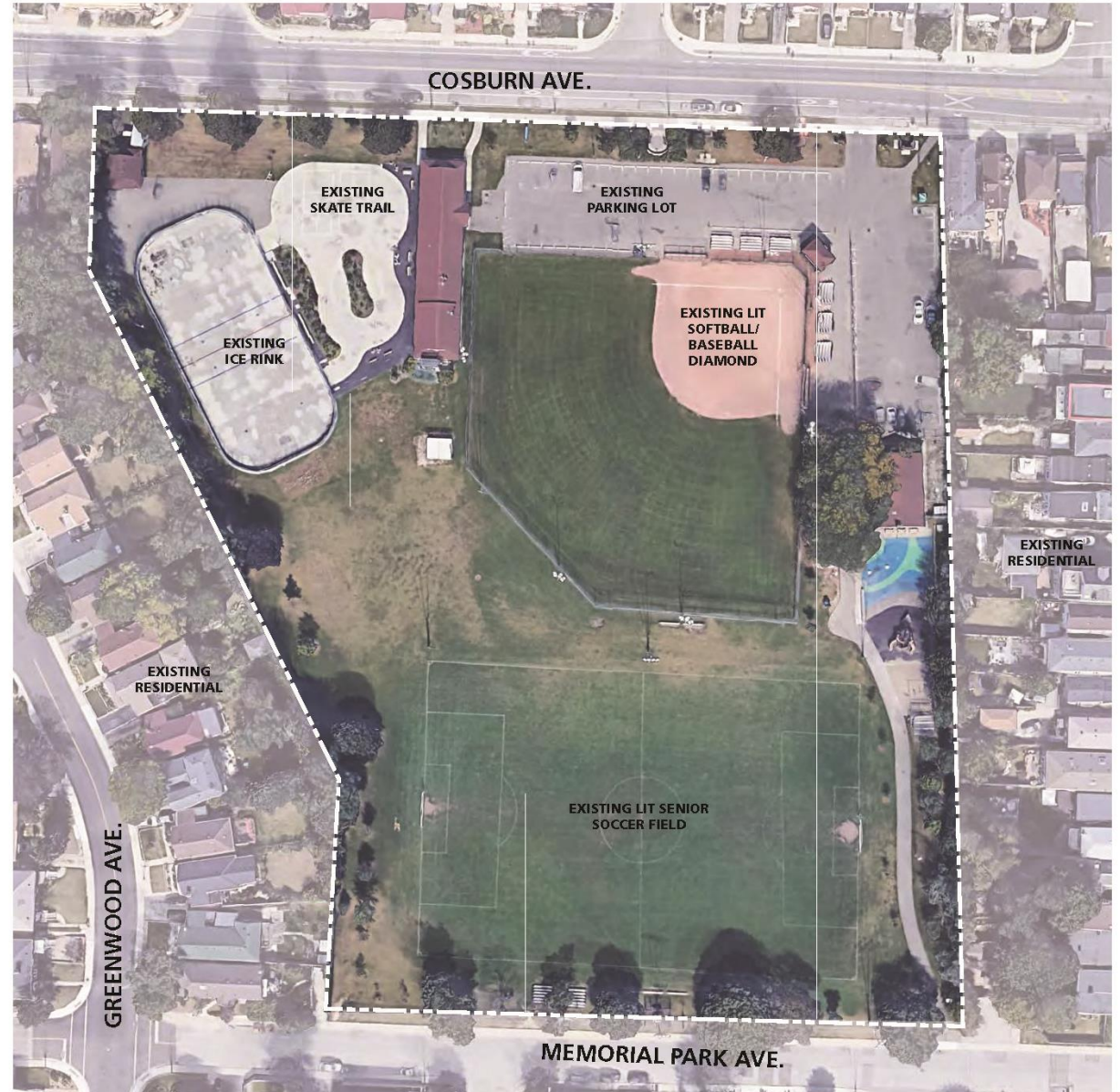
# Existing Park



- 48% - Structured Active Sports (14,362m²)
- 33% - Greenspace (9,914m²)
- 2% - Playground (570m²)
- 6% - Trail & Path (1,900m²)
- 2% - Buildings (730m²)
- 8% - Parking Lot (2,384m²)

Total Park Area  $\approx 29,860\text{m}^2 \approx 7.4$  Acres

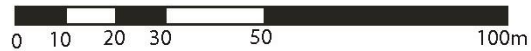

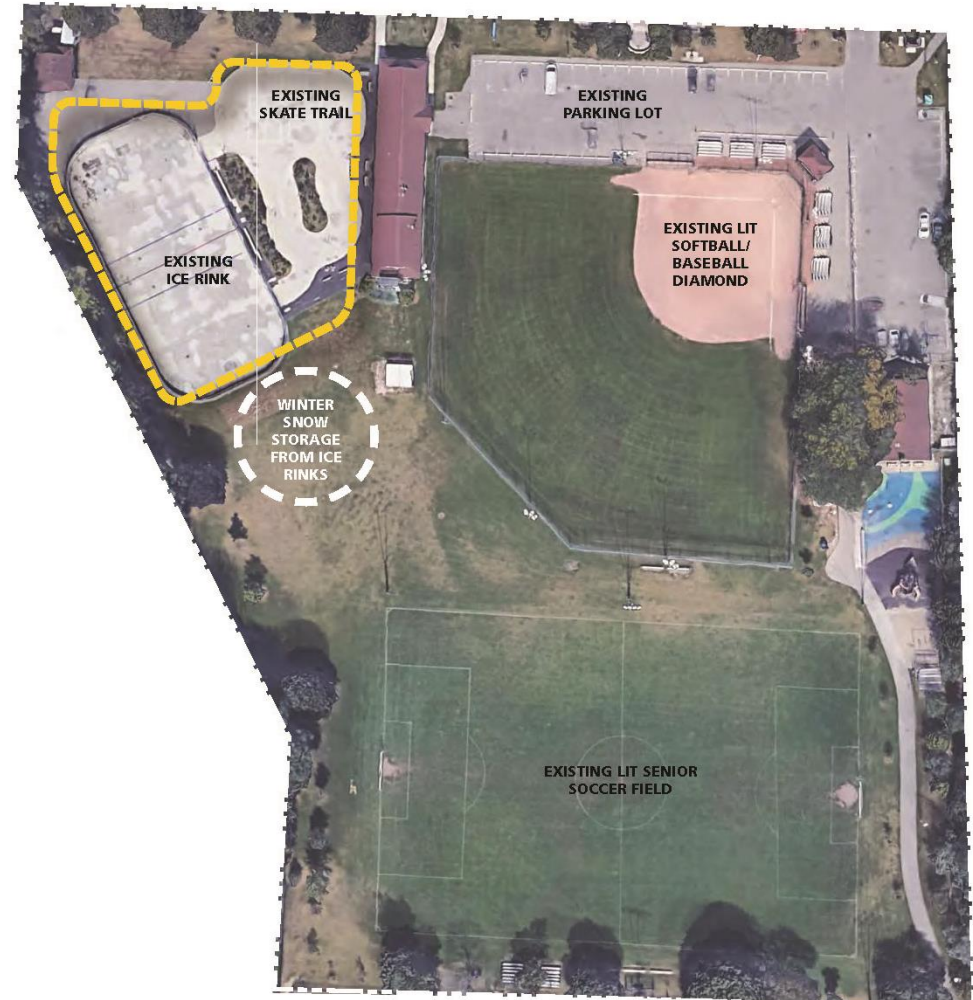

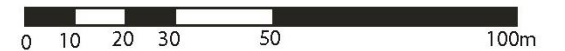

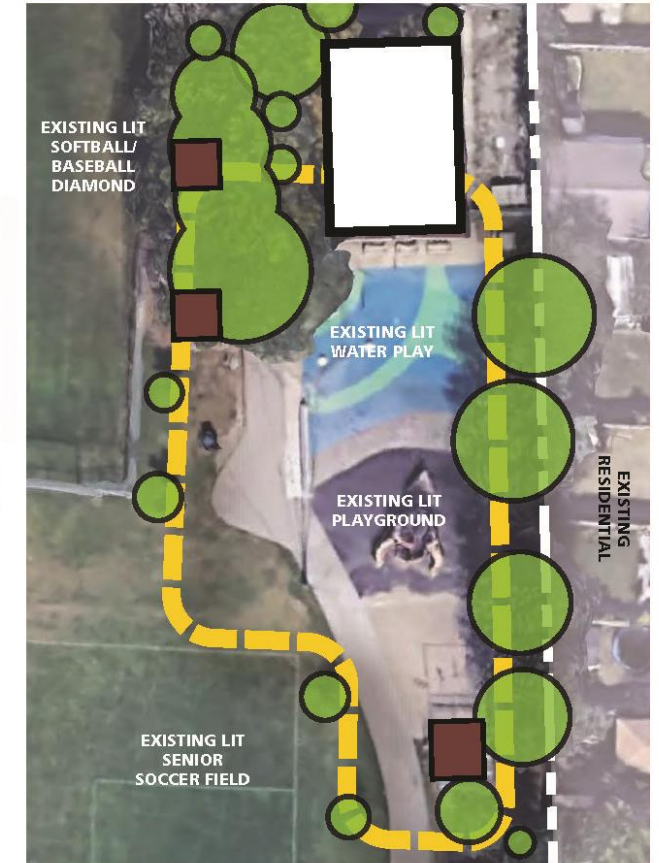

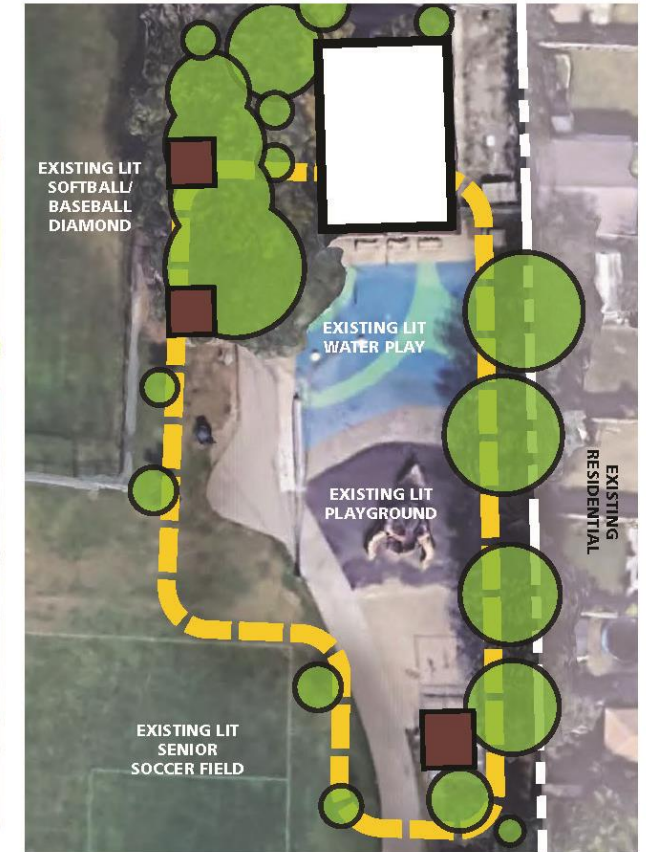

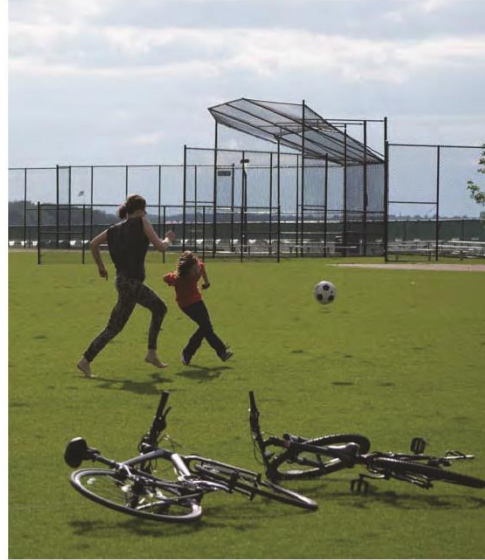
