**DECISION:**

- 2. Niroshan Murugathasan** (Report No. 7424)  
Applicant for the Renewal of Tow Truck Driver's Licence No. D09-4977682

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

"Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be renewed, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) The Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be suspended for four (4) consecutive dates commencing at 12:01 am on May 7, 2021 and ending at 11:59 pm on May 10, 2021;
- (3) The Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Niroshan Murugathasan is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Niroshan Murugathasan and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Niroshan Murugathasan's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Niroshan Murugathasan or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7424 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.
- (5) Prior to the next licence renewal, Niroshan Murugathasan must submit, to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards, proof of completion of a Defensive Driving Course with the Ontario Safety Council in one of the following ways:
  - via regular mail to: 850 Coxwell Ave, Toronto, Ontario M4C 5R1;
  - via email to [mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca](mailto:mlsconditionreporting@toronto.ca); or
  - via fax at 416-392-3102.
- (6) If Niroshan Murugathasan is unable to complete said Defensive Driving Course by the next licence renewal date, then prior to the next licence renewal date, Niroshan Murugathasan will advise MLS in one of the above-noted ways that he was unable to complete said Defensive Driving Course due to the closure of driving schools under the Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020 S.O. 2020, c. 17. The deadline for Niroshan Murugathasan to submit proof of completion of a Defensive Driving Course to Municipal Licensing and Standards will then be extended for a period of 90 days.”
