# TTC Track Replacement and Streetscape Improvements on Wellington Street from Yonge Street to Church Street

**Contract: 20ECS-TI-20SP****New Start Date: Spring 2022****New End Date: Summer 2022***\*Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.*

As announced in the last Construction Update, the City has halted construction work until spring 2022 due to the discovery of underground conflicts. The City will be working closely with affected utilities to address and resolve the challenges ahead of restarting construction.

As we prepare to re-start construction in spring 2022, the City will be connecting with property managers of impacted properties along Wellington Street E to review detailed construction information and scheduling as required.

## WHAT TO EXPECT – WELLINGTON STREET RESTORATION

- Wellington Street will be restored to two lanes of westbound traffic
- All sidewalks have been temporarily restored with asphalt and delineated with painted lines
- Concrete barriers and fences have been installed along Wellington Street and Front Street to provide a safe separation of pedestrian traffic and road users and protect pole bases for project that have been installed
- Project team is working on developing an aesthetic treatment for pole bases that are currently exposed to replace orange construction barrels
- All garbage receptacles will be restored to original locations along Wellington Street and Front Street
- Café TO applicants have access to their patio spaces
- Project team is working on clearing utility conflicts and securing approvals for revised design of certain streetscape elements that were altered to accommodate unforeseen underground conditions and issues
