City Construction on Dovercourt Road from Sudbury Street to College Street and Lisgar Street from Queen Street West to Dundas Street West

This notice provides an update on a number of construction projects in the Beaconsfield Village neighbourhood, specifically on Dovercourt Road and Lisgar Street.

The City of Toronto is currently finalizing watermain and substandard water service replacement work on Dovercourt Road from St. Anne's to College Street.

The City has completed the sewer and watermain replacement work on Lisgar Street and is now finalizing restoration work.

Remaining work on Dovercourt Road is expected to be complete by August 20, 2021.

We recognize that these projects continue to have an impact on all businesses and residents in the area. We sympathize and appreciate your patience with the dust, noise, parking, traffic disruptions, construction fencing and other inconveniences.

Please be advised that this work will continue to have an impact on traffic / parking in the neighbourhood, particularly on Dovercourt Road (Dundas St to College St).

This work will take approximately 1 week. <i>A separate notice for this work will be issued in advance.</i>

	<p>Dovercourt Road from Dundas Street West to College Street The current temporary southbound ONLY operation (College Street to Dundas Street West) will continue to be in place until work is completed on August 20, 2021.</p>
	<p>Lisgar Street from Queen Street West to Dundas Street West Given that work on Lisgar Street is nearly completed, road closures at this time are not required. Additional segments of Lisgar Street from Queen Street West to Argyle Street still need to be resurfaced, which will require a short road closure. A separate notice will be mailed closer to the work start date with additional information.</p>
