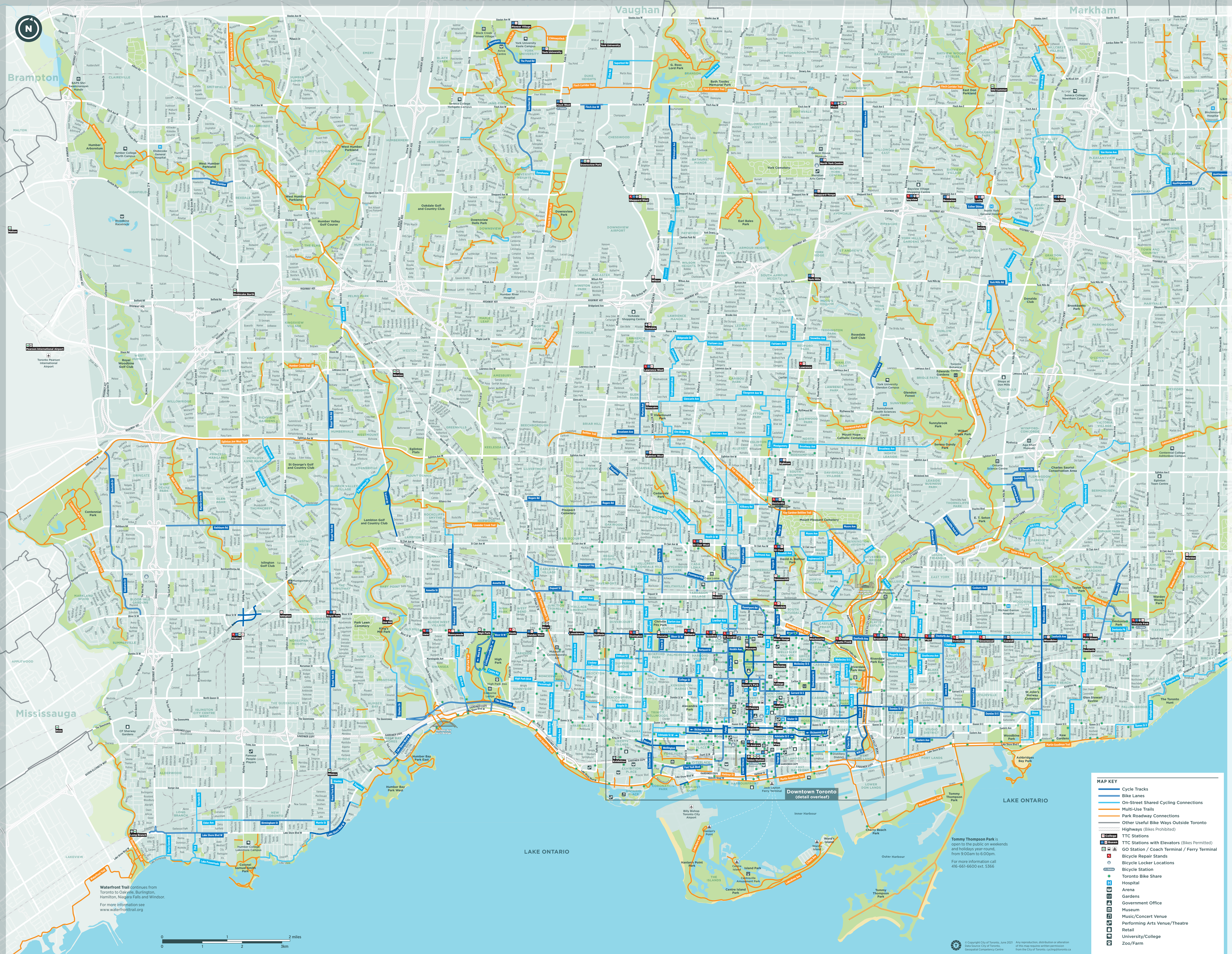




Welcome to the Toronto Cycling Map

The Toronto Cycling Map is a great resource for planning your route to work, school, shopping, or simply to explore. The Map shows on and off-street bikeways, suggested routes and connections, and other important information about cycling in Toronto.

This map has been developed to assist in planning bicycle trips throughout the City. The designation of a street on the map as a bicycle lane, route or pathway does not necessarily guarantee any minimum lane width. Cyclists must use these streets with the same caution they would use when riding on similar streets that have not been so designated. All routes should be evaluated by each individual cyclist based on their level of experience, comfort level in cycling in traffic, weather conditions, time of day, and any road obstacles, whether temporary or permanent, such as construction or pot holes. This map is not intended as a guide for children. The City is not responsible for any unforeseeable offences committed by third parties, which may cause hazard to cyclists.
