Sidewalk Installation on Dwight Avenue from Birmingham Street to Maple Boulevard

Due to concerns about tree removals, the sidewalk installation on Dwight Avenue from Birmingham Street to Maple Boulevard has been placed on hold. The City of Toronto is currently reviewing various options. Public consultation will be arranged and the community will be informed accordingly. A construction update will be issued once new details are confirmed.

This project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program to renew aging City roads and sidewalk for current and future needs.
