Update on the proposal for affordable homes with supports at 75 Tandridge Crescent

Dear neighbours,

We are writing to provide an update on the City of Toronto's proposal to build a five-storey supportive housing building at 75 Tandridge Crescent. Due to the technical work needed on the site, we are not able to complete the project within the Rapid Housing Initiative timeline and so **this project is no longer under consideration.**

We thank all neighbours who have taken the time to attend a community meeting and/or provide feedback on this proposal to date.

There are more than 7,800 people experiencing homelessness in Toronto. Supportive housing saves lives by connecting people experiencing, or at risk of, homelessness to vital supports and services. The City is committed to increasing the supply of affordable housing and continues to look for available sites to meet its target of creating 18,000 supportive homes by 2030.
