This SMIS enhancement (August 2021) release version 3.6 addresses the highest priority change requests in SMIS.

There are a total of 6 enhancement areas in this release, of which most will be apparent to all end users. All changes are detailed in the following pages.

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1. Enhance the SMIS Incident Module

- 1. As part of a series of changes to the SMIS Incident Module in order to improve Workplace Violence tracking per the Ontario Health and Safety Act (OHSA), the following enhancements were made:
 - a) Improve the visuals of the module.
 - b) Improve accessibility (e.g., screen reader support, font/colour, headers)
 - c) Add new help text as follows, in the [Nature of Incident] Section to better inform users of the intent of the field:
 - "This section allows you to clarify the nature of the incident that occurred. Please select all of the options that apply. Some of the options will require you to answer a follow-up question to clarify whether the nature of the incident meets one of the definitions of workplace violence and therefore is considered a workplace violence incident."
 - d) Add "(or attempt)" to the following 2 existing [Nature of Incident] checkbox options to more closely align with OHSA definitions:
 - Physical Assault Against Resident (or attempt)
 - Physical Assault Against Staff (or attempt)
 - e) Add the following 3 new [Nature of Incident] checkbox options to more closely align with OHSA definitions:
 - Wielding weapon or dangerous object
 - Possession of firearm within the site
 - Other behaviours that compromised health/safety of other(s)
 - f) Add new "Workplace Violence" sub-fields (Yes/No toggle) to the [Nature of Incident] field, based on OHSA definitions. These fields will ONLY display if the user selects the associated [Nature of Incident] checkbox option.

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2. Add New Dispositions and Reasons to the End-of-Service Module

This change allows service programs to record a broader range of Dispositions and Reasons that are applicable to their service, as identified by Streets-2-Homes program leads. Note that these new Dispositions and Reasons will **not** be added to the "Discharge" module for bedded programs. They will only be added to the "End-of-Service" module for service programs.

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3. Add "Updated By" Column to Referral List Page

In the referral list page, the current "Staff" column name will be changed to "Created By" and a new column with heading "Update By" will be added. These 2 columns will be populated with the staff name who created the referral and the staff who last updated the referral.

- Program Area
- Program Model
- Overnight Service Type
- Public Name
- Allow Bed Request
- Allow Referral To
- Location is Confidential
- Disable the Auto-expiring of Bed Requests from Service Intake
