

As mentioned in the previous notice, in preparation for construction near your area, the contractor will have to remove City-owned trees from the City's boulevard and some of the trees and shrubs within the ravine directly east and west of Royal York Road. Due to delay in the contractor's construction schedule, the removals will start the week of October 18, 2021.

WORK DESCRIPTION

The City of Toronto will replace the culvert at Royal York Road over the Humber River Tributary. This work will ensure that the culvert meets today's standards and remains safe for vehicles and pedestrians into the future. The project is part of the Council-approved 2021 Capital Works Program.

Due to the nature of this project and access to the construction area, the City will have to remove one hundred and one (101) trees and shrubs within the ravine directly east and west of Royal York Road starting the week of October 18, 2021.

All trees that are removed will be replaced with 115 new trees and 80 shrubs when construction is completed and restoration work on the project is taking place.
