# Sewer Pipe Repair near the Avoca Parks Yard Rosehill Reservoir Rehabilitation

# Contract #: 17ECS-MI-03WA Start Date: Monday October 25, 2021 End Date: Mid-November, 2021 \*Timeline is weather dependent and subject to change.

The City's Contractor will be excavating near the Avoca Garden Beds to repair the existing sewer pipe that services the Avoca Parks Yard. This sewer connection needs to be replaced as it was recently damaged due to other construction activities in the area. This work is expected to start on Monday October 25<sup>th</sup> and will be completed by mid-November, 2021 (weather permitting).

The work site will impact the north-east corner of the park including the sidewalk on the east side of Avoca Avenue. Traffic will be maintained and continue around this work site. After the sewer replacement work is completed, the site fencing will be removed and any disturbed areas will be restored.

# WORK DETAILS

This work will involve:

- Installation of the temporary fencing near the Avoca Garden beds
- Excavation of an open trench near the Avoca Garden beds and near the Avoca Parks Yard
- Directional drilling to install a new section of pipe between the two excavation pits
