

Construction Update #3

August 13, 2021

Watermain Replacement on Broadview Avenue from Danforth Avenue to Gerrard Street East

Contract: 21ECS-TI-13SP Expected Start Date: May 10, 2021 Expected End Date: Spring, 2022

*Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.

As watermain installation work continues on Broadview Avenue, please note that heavy construction activity will be continuing in the Broadview Avenue and Danforth Avenue area. Our contractor has recently received another shipment of pipe and will begin installing 180 metres of watermain pipe starting near Loblaw's, moving north to Danforth Avenue. We expect this work to be completed by August 20th. While working in the Broadview Avenue and Danforth Avenue area our contractor will create and maintain delivery and drop off zones for business along this stretch through the remainder of the work.

From August 20th to 27th the contractor will be flushing and pressure testing the new watermain. During this time there will be minimal activity on the construction site. Test results are expected the week of September 3rd. Once all regulatory testing is passed our contractor will begin to transfer the water services to the new watermain. This work is scheduled to start during the week of September 6th to September 11th

Once all service connections are complete in the Broadview Avenue and Danforth Avenue area, watermain installation will continue from Montcrest Avenue working south towards Gerrard Street. Prior to any water service disruption, residents will be notified two days (48hrs) prior to disruption by our contractor. All other projects scheduled for this area are still on schedule, please see Other Work in Area chart for all project status updates.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO


