### Road Reconstruction on Heathdale Road, Humewood Drive & Glen Cedar Road

#### Contract: 20ECS-TI-02LR Start Date: August 3, 2021 End Date: September 30, 2021 Revised End Date: November 12, 2021 \*Timeline is subject to change.

This notice provides an update on the progress of City construction on Heathdale Road, Humewood Drive and Glen Cedar Road. Construction is scheduled for completion by November 12.

Please read below for information about what to do if you receive a parking ticket while temporarily parking on a side street.


#### WORK STATUS TO DATE

- Replaced substandard water services
- Replaced curb and sidewalk
- Replaced catchbasins

- From now until mid-November, the contractor will:
  - Excavate the road
  - Build curbs and sidewalks
  - Complete reconstruction of the road base and new asphalt
  - Complete sod and site restoration

# Construction Update #1

	<b>Physical Distancing:</b> There are times when contractors need to communicate with homeowners about what is happening on-site. This could be about driveway access, water shut offs, pre-construction inspections, and site restoration work (landscaping, installing pavers etc.). Contractor's staff will be identifiable by their high-visibility clothing and will maintain physical distancing.
	<b>Site Safety:</b> Workers on site are responsible for the work assigned to them. If you have construction questions or an issue on site – ask to be directed to the site inspector. If the site inspector is unavailable, contact the person listed at the end of this notice.
8	<b>Traffic Management</b> : Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets. Motorists are reminded that bicycles and cars will be sharing the lane. When driving, please be mindful of vulnerable road users. <b>Traffic on Humewood Drive and Heathdale Road will have localized</b>
$\mathbf{R}$	disruptions.  Parking: This project will affect on-street parking. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. Please call 416-808-2222 for its location.
	<ul> <li>Parking Violation Notice: If parking enforcement is called to a street, officers must issue a yellow parking violation notice (ticket) to vehicles in violation of parking by-laws. If you receive a yellow notice during this construction work, do the following within 15 days of the notice date:</li> <li>1) Contact the site inspector or person listed on the Construction Notice and give them the yellow notice number.</li> <li>2) Dispute the parking violation notice online or in person following the process listed on the back of the parking violation notice.</li> <li>You may use this construction notice as part of the explanation of why the violation should be cancelled. Please note: violation notices cannot be cancelled if vehicles are parked in illegal parking spots (i.e. in front of a fire hydrant or in no parking zones).</li> <li>In an effort to reduce ticketing due to construction, please exercise patience with neighbours who are experiencing construction and may need to temporarily park on your street.</li> </ul>
Ġ	Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, please inform the <b>Project Manager</b> listed below.
	<b>Restoration:</b> The construction work area will be restored with sod, concrete and/or asphalt where required. Interlocking bricks, flagstone on a granular base, or other similar features that are removed from public and private property during construction will be replaced. Lawn seeding and/or laying of sod will be done as needed.
