City Infrastructure Work on Bertrand Avenue, Ionview Road, Richome Court, Rosemount Drive

Contract: 21ECS-TI-101LR
Start Date: May 25, 2021; Original End Date: November 15, 2021
Revised End Date: July 15, 2022
Winter Break: December 22, 2021 to April 14, 2022

*Timeline is subject to change.

In May 2021, the City of Toronto started infrastructure improvements on Bertrand Avenue, Ionview Road, Richome Court, and Rosemount Drive (see map on reverse). This notice provides an update on the construction on each of these roads.

Rosemount Drive and Richome Court: Construction will be tentatively completed by December 22, 2021, including permanent restoration, top soil and sod (weather permitting).

Bertrand Avenue: All sidewalk and driveway work is complete. Traffic signal upgrades at the Birchmount Road and Bertrand Avenue intersection will be tentatively completed by December 22, 2021. In spring 2022, the contractors will return to grind the road surface, pave with new asphalt, install speed bumps, finish any remaining concrete work and complete boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.


lonview Road: All driveway restoration work will be completed by December 22, 2021. In spring 2022, the contractors will return to grind the road surface, pave with new asphalt and complete boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.

To ensure Bertrand Avenue and Ionview Road are safe for the winter, the City's contractor will fill any open excavations and temporarily restore affected areas before demobilizing in 2021. You will receive a Construction Update Notice prior to work restarting in spring 2022.
