Ridge Gallery Rentals

September – December 2022

Artist Information:

Apply for a short term gallery space rental during the months of September to December to exhibit and sell your visual artwork at the beautiful, historic Cedar Ridge Creative Centre. Gallery rentals are available on a biweekly basis from September – December 2022. Cedar Ridge, an accessible facility, welcomes artists of all abilities, individual artists and/or artist collectives, as well as professional and emerging artists. The facility offers three main floor gallery spaces.

Rental rates are \$520.00 (HST included) for two weeks for all three rooms.

A commission of 20% is collected on sales, which goes to Cedar Ridge Studio Gallery, a not-for-profit organization. All commissions support the operation of the Cedar Ridge Gallery.

No fee is required for submitting an application. Applications are assessed by a jury. Results will be emailed out in January 2022.

Deadline for Submissions: Monday, November 22, 2021.

Submission Requirements:

- Application form
- Up-to-date curriculum vitae, maximum 3 pages
- Cover letter, maximum 1 page
- Artist statement (including the media, technique, theme or context of your artwork), max 1 page
- Maximum of 10 digital images of recent works and up to 3 videos. Please format images as JPEGs. The images should imply the general idea, theme or impression of the proposed exhibit. Half of the images submitted must be of works included in the exhibit (if works are not an installation).
- Corresponding list of images containing title, dimensions, and medium.

Image Specifications:

- PC-compatible files only
- JPEG format only
- Image resolution: 72 dpi – 300 dpi
- Image size: Maximum of 500KB (0.5 MB each)
- RGB or SRGB colour mode files only (no CMYK)

Please do not submit:

- MAC files that are not fully PC compatible
- Any type of presentation format
- Zipped, Stuffit, or other compressed files
- Any digital materials that require software, plugins, extensions or other

Image Specifications:

- Images must be labelled: name of applicant, title of the work, followed by a number (example: J. Doe_Untitled_01)

Please do not submit:

executables to be downloaded or installed will not be reviewed.

Ensure that a PC computer can process all document and image files. It is your responsibility to ensure that submitted files are not corrupted, illegible or improperly formatted. Please send your entry information as a WORD (.doc) or PDF (.pdf) documents, and all image files as JPEGs.

Exhibition Information:

- Floor Plan provided
- Artists may hang or anchor exhibitions by use of the chains and "S" hooks or nails provided by the gallery
- Artists may have use of display pedestals with Plexiglas tops
- All work must be professionally presented and ready to hang with wire and screw eyes
- Artists are responsible for installation and de-installation of their exhibit
- Installation will occur on a Friday from 12pm to 4pm. De-installation will be on a Friday from 9am to 12pm
- Artists must indicate prices for pieces for retail and/or insurance purposes
- Upon acceptance, a \$50 deposit will be required
- A 20% commission on all sales resulting from the exhibition will be retained by Cedar Ridge Gallery, a not-for-profit organization, and help to cover gallery operational costs.

Included with Rental Fee:

- Art insurance coverage
- *Space/time for opening reception, **where allowed under current health regulations**
- PDF invitation
- Gallery Maintenance
- Free parking

* Reception must adhere to all current Toronto Public Health and Provincial regulations

Cedar Ridge Gallery Covid Protocols:

- Cedar Ridge Gallery is located in Cedar Ridge Creative Centre, a City of Toronto operated facility
- All Covid protocols and procedures as per Toronto Public Health and the Province of Ontario Guidelines are adhered to
- Health Screening, Contact Tracing, Masking, Physical Distancing, Enhanced Cleaning and Occupancy Limits are currently in place
