About the Project – Silver Creek Park Today


- 3.9 hectare park
- Located at 44 Strathdee Dr. near Islington Avenue & Eglinton Avenue West.







Project Timeline



Silver Creek Park Today

- The park currently includes:
 - ball diamond
 - outdoor tennis courts
 - a playground
 - a drinking fountain







Proposed Improvements

- The proposed park improvements include:
 - An outdoor ping pong table
 - Outdoor fitness equipment
 - An accessible disc swing
 - Picnic tables
 - Shade structure for sand play area
 - New water fountain/bottle filler
 - Additional seating
 - Accessible pathway
- The project will **not** include improvements to Richmond Gardens Pool or the associated building







Proposed Park Improvements Concept Design



Proposed Improvements

The proposed improvements for Silver Creek Park will include new amenities in two separate areas of the park:

- Main improvements in the **west** side of the park (Site 1)
- Secondary improvements in the **east** side of the park (Site 2)





Proposed Improvements – West Side (Site 1)

The proposed concept plan for the west side (site 1) of the park includes:

- 1. Accessible Path loop extension
- 2. Group swing
- 3. Outdoor fitness area
- 4. Shade Canopy (Pending budget availability)
- 5. Accessible picnic table area with shade and concrete seatwall (numbers 5 and 13)
- 6. Table tennis
- 7. New trees
- 8. Pollinator Garden (pending budget availability and community interest)
- 9. Bench seating
- 10. Garbage/Recycling Area
- 11. Picnic Tables
- 12. Drinking fountain and bottle filler (relocated closer to the existing pathway entrance)





Proposed Improvements – East Side (Site 2)

The proposed concept plan for the east side (site 2) includes:

- An accessible pathway connection to the sidewalk/ crosswalk
- 2. New lowmaintenance plantings (Provisional)
- 3. A "quiet zone" seating area with accessible benches
- 4. New trees


