Watermain Replacement on Broadview Avenue from Danforth Avenue to Gerrard Street East

Contract: 21ECS-TI-13SP
Expected Start Date: May 10, 2021
Expected End Date: Spring, 2022

**Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.*

As watermain work continues on Broadview Avenue, we are pleased to update the community that all regulatory water testing has been passed. **The contractor will begin to transfer the water services to the new watermain between Danforth Avenue and Sparkhall Avenue.** This work is scheduled to start during the week of December 6th and continue through the week of December 13th.

During this time, the contractor will carry out watermain street connections on Tennis Crescent, Millbrook Crescent and Sparkhall Avenue. **This work involves temporary water shut offs for impacted areas,** between approximately 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. daily. A written notice will be provided to all impacted residents 48 hours in advance.

Once street connections are completed, Toronto Water will test water samples. If the water samples pass inspection, the contractor will continue with street and water service connections on Broadview Avenue, from December 10-17th. Watermain installation will continue from Jack Layton Way, with crews working south towards Gerrard Street until December 17th.

Once water service connections are completed, construction activities will be temporarily shut down by December 24th. During the temporary shutdown all traffic lanes and on-street parking on Broadview Avenue will be reopened.

The Contractor will resume construction activities in early January 2022 and continue with the water service and watermain street connections until Spring of 2022. Please see the 'Other Work In The Area' chart for the status of other construction projects in the area.

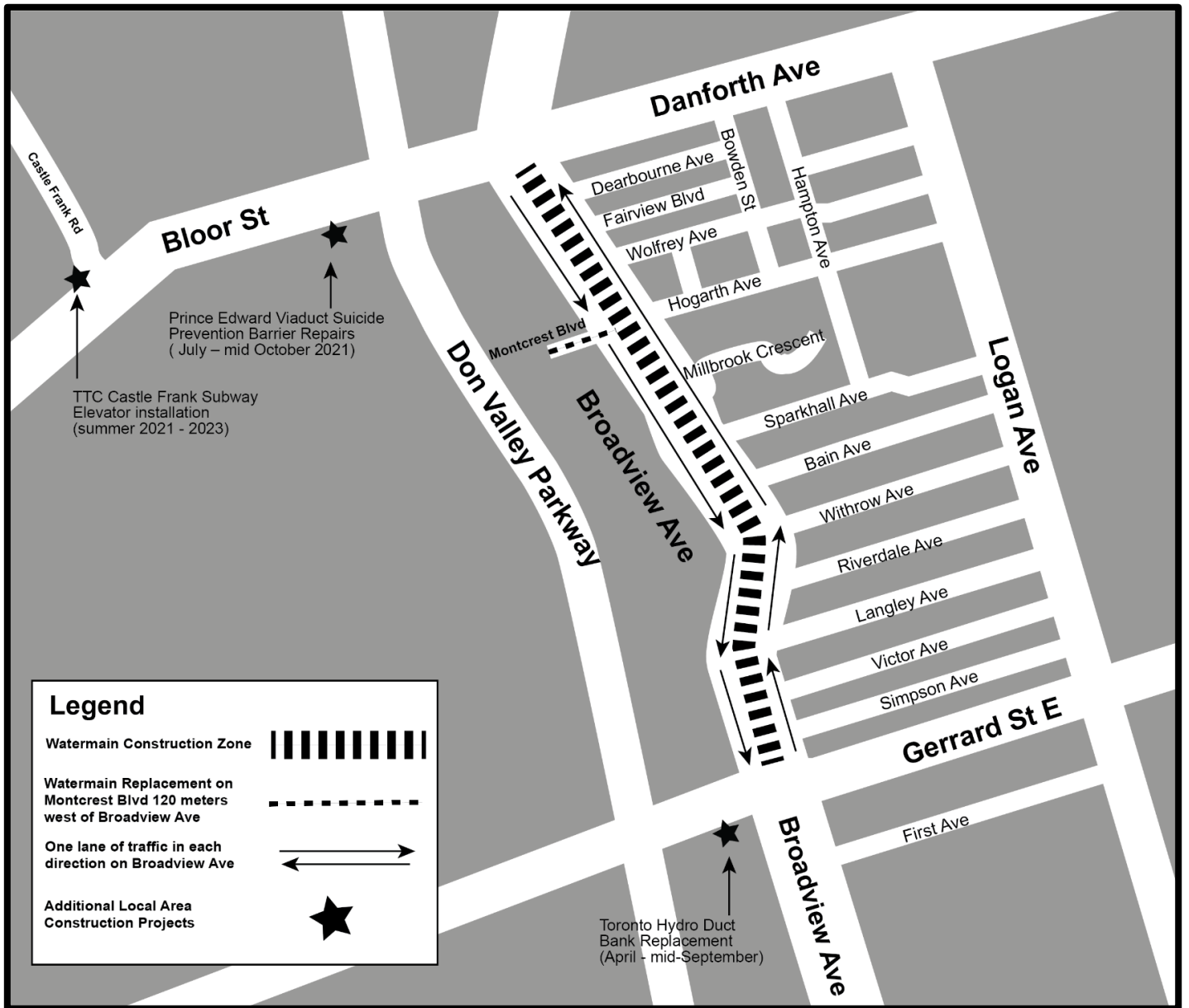
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID 19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO
