Road Resurfacing and Bikeway Pavement Markings on Birmingham Street from Dwight Avenue to Islington Avenue

In June, the City of Toronto started road resurfacing and bikeway pavement markings on Birmingham Street from Dwight Avenue to Islington Avenue.

To date, construction of sidewalks, curbs, road resurfacing and bikeway pavement markings have been completed. Due to winter weather conditions, permanent restoration of the driveways, topsoil and sod work has been suspended until spring next year.

All temporary restoration work is expected to be completed by December 23, 2021 to make the street safe for the winter. Traffic Signal Electrical work at the intersection of Dwight Avenue, Birmingham Street and Murrie Street will occur in January-February 2022.

In May 2022, the contractors will return to finish any remaining permanent driveway restoration work and complete boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.

You will receive a Construction Update Notice prior to work restarting in spring 2022.
