**TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL ELECTRONIC HEARING:

**1. Angus Njoku (Report No. 7572)**

Holder of Toronto Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V00-4807678

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Interim Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

- (1) "The Tribunal proceeding in this matter shall be adjourned sine die, pending the disposition of the criminal charges against Angus Njoku, or may be returned sooner if either party so requests;
- (2) The Toronto Taxicab Owner's Licence shall be suspended until further order of the Tribunal;
- (3) Angus Njoku shall inform Municipal Licensing and Standards (MLS) of any disposition of the criminal charges against him, in writing, within three (3) business days. Angus Njoku can notify MLS in one of the following ways:

**2. Mahamed Ali Mahamud (Report No. 7670)**

Holder of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4713349

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment of this matter sine die, pending the disposition of the charges against Mahamed Ali Mahamud, or sooner if either party so requests, on consent.

**3. Mykhaylo Antonov (Report No. 7659)**  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. C114508)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, originally signed on November 23, 2021, as follows:

"Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be issued to Mykhaylo Antonov, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Mykhaylo Antonov is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Mykhaylo Antonov and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Mykhaylo Antonov's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (3) Prior to each of the next two (2) renewal(s) of the licence, Mykhaylo Antonov must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Mykhaylo Antonov or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7659 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
