The City is pleased to inform the Broadview community that our contractor has been able to secure the necessary materials to commence watermain replacement work ahead of schedule. The current watermain work on Moncrest Avenue and Hogarth Avenue will be completed during the week of July 5th.

Watermain installation work will restart on Broadview Avenue the week of July 12th. During the week of July 5th, please expect our contractor to be mobilizing heavy equipment in various locations on Broadview Avenue. Construction work will start at Hogarth Avenue and work north towards Broadview Avenue. All other projects scheduled for this area are still on schedule, please see Other Work in Area chart for all project status updates.

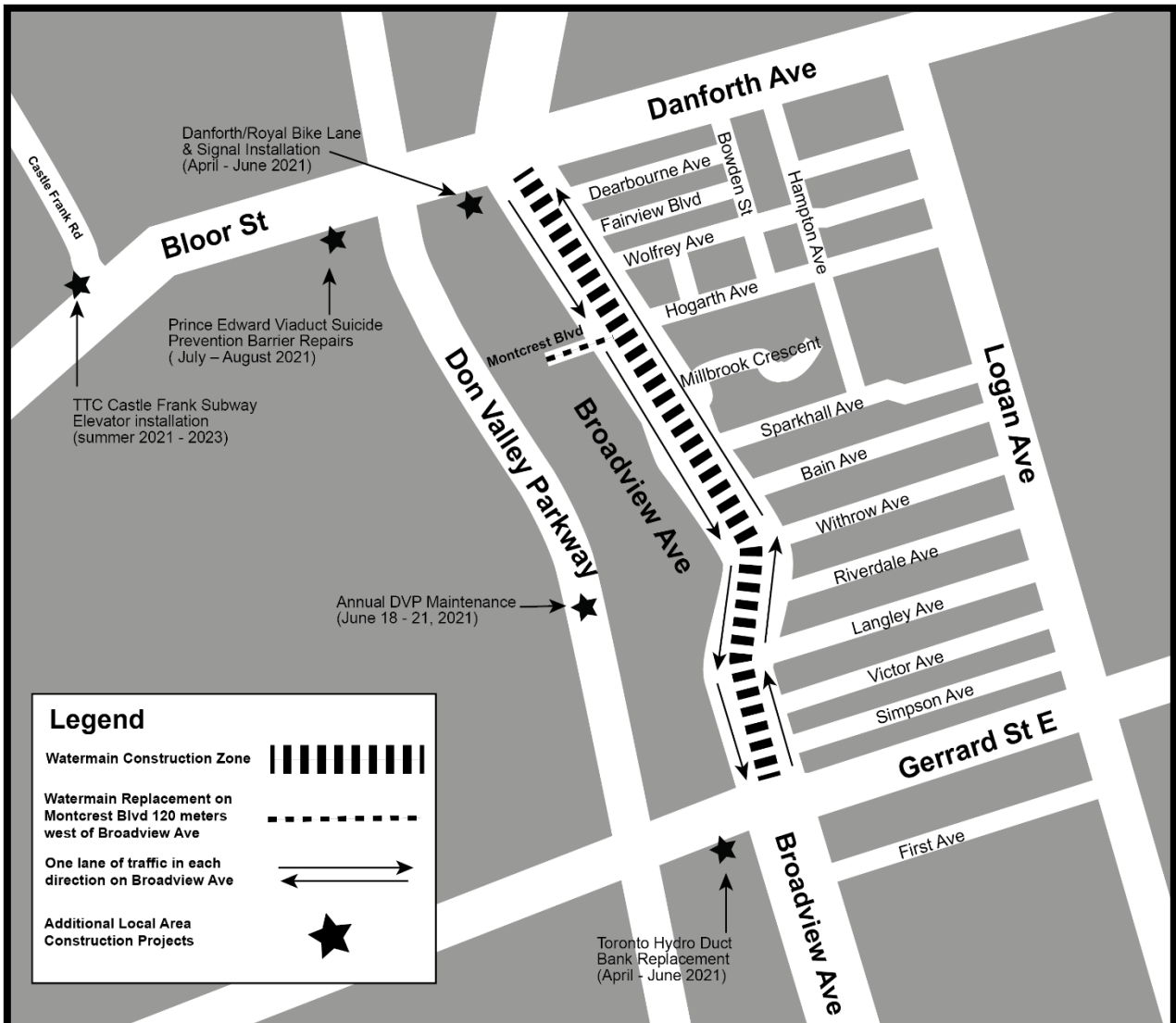
IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO
