Road Reconstruction on Murrie Street

Contract: 21ECS-TI-102LR Start Date: June 28, 2021 End Date: December 31, 2021 Revised End Date: June 2022 Winter Break: December 23, 2021 to Early May 2022.

*Timeline is subject to change.

In June, the City of Toronto started Road Reconstruction on Murrie Street.

To date, replacement of substandard water services and construction of sidewalks, curbs and gutters have been completed. Due to winter weather conditions, road reconstruction followed by permanent restoration of the driveways, topsoil and sod work has been suspended until spring next year.

All temporary driveway restoration work is expected to be completed by December 23, 2021. Traffic Signal Electrical work at the intersection of Dwight Avenue, Birmingham Street and Murrie Street will occur in January-February 2022. To ensure Murrie Street is safe for the winter, the City's contractor will fill any open excavations and temporarily restore affected areas before demobilizing in 2021

In May 2022, the contractors will return to do road reconstruction work, pave the road with new asphalt, and complete any outstanding permanent restoration of driveways and boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.

You will receive a Construction Update Notice prior to work restarting in spring 2022.
