**Re: Revocation of COVID-19 orders and letters of instruction**

I am writing to inform you that, effective March 1, 2022, upon Ontario entering the Roadmap Exit Step under the *Reopening Ontario Act*, I am revoking the following COVID-19 orders and letters of instruction:

- Class Orders issued under section 22 of the *Health Protection and Promotion Act*
  - COVID-19 Self-Isolation Class Order (issued on January 10, 2022)
  - Class Order to Close Workplaces to Manage COVID-19 Outbreaks (issued on April 22, 2021)
  - Class Order for Workplaces Experiencing a COVID-19 Outbreak (issued on March 3, 2021)
- Letters of Instruction issued under the *Reopening Ontario Act* regulations:
  - Instructions for Indoor Sports and Recreational Fitness Facilities (issued on October 8, 2021)
  - Instructions for Workplaces (issued on January 4, 2021).
