
In 2020, the City of Toronto installed the **SHAW STREET SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT** 

between Dupont Street and Dewson Street. It has resulted in an overall increase in cycling volumes and a decrease in motor-vehicle traffic volumes on Shaw Street and connecting local streets. The project included changing the direction of motor vehicle traffic flow on Shaw Street and adjacent streets, installing a cycling-only block and upgrading the contra-flow bicycle lanes.
