## **Road Reconstruction on Murrie Street**

## Contract: 21ECS-TI-102LR Start Date: June 28, 2021 End Date: December 31, 2021 Revised End Date: May 27, 2022 Winter Break: December 23, 2021, to April 17, 2022

In June, 2021, the City of Toronto started Road Reconstruction on Murrie Street.

To date, replacement of substandard water services and construction of sidewalks, curbs, and gutters have been completed. The contractor has also completed the Traffic Signal Electrical work at the intersection of Dwight Avenue, Birmingham Street and Murrie Street.

On April 18, 2022, the contractor will resume road reconstruction by removing and replacing the entire road structure (asphalt and underlying support materials), paving the road with new asphalt, and completing any outstanding permanent restoration of driveways and boulevard restoration with topsoil and sod.
