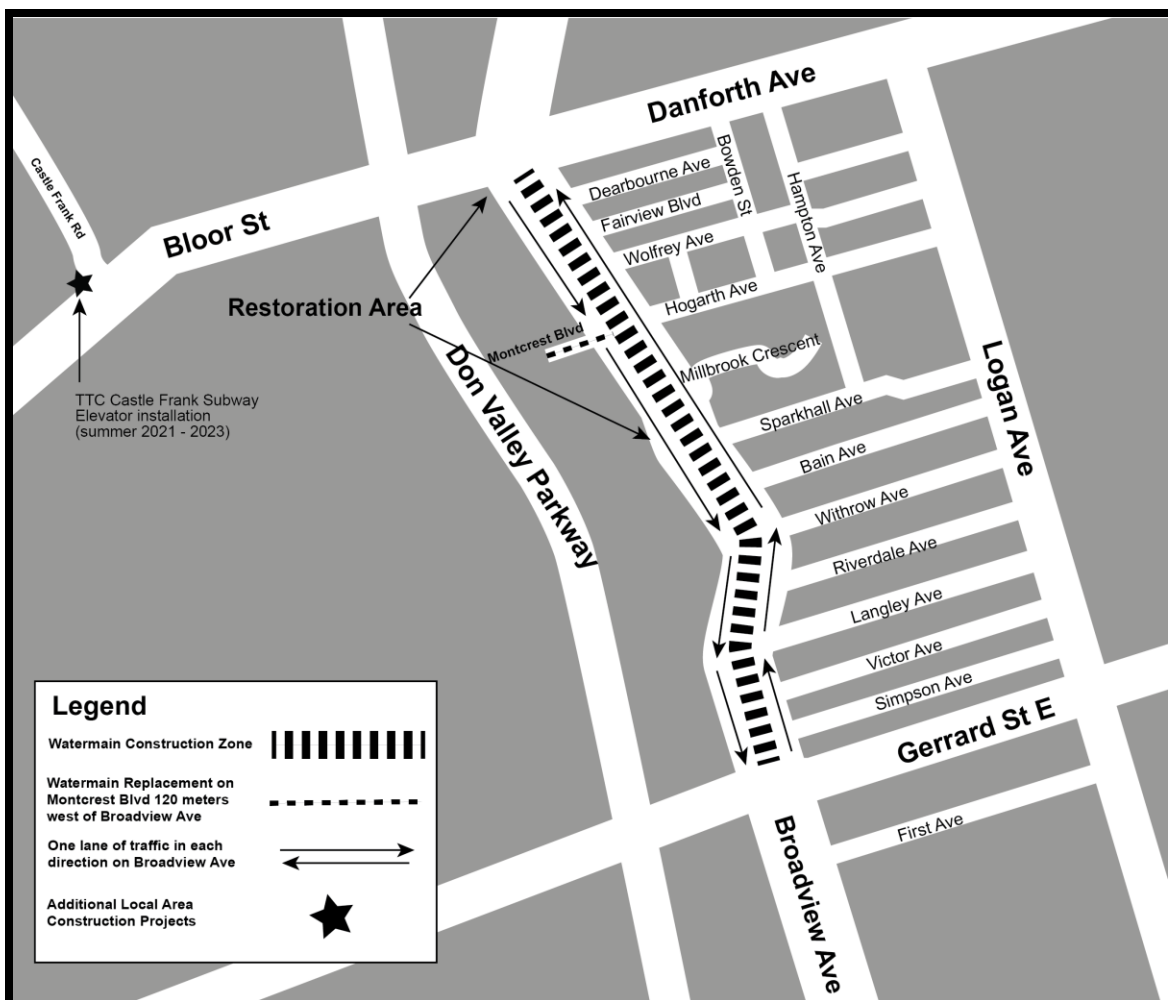
As watermain work continues on Broadview Avenue, we are pleased to update the community that road and sidewalk restoration work is tentatively scheduled to start in the area of Broadview Avenue and Danforth Avenue during the week of April 4th. If work is delayed during the week of April 4th, work will start during the week of April 11th.

We anticipate that Broadview Avenue restoration work from Danforth Avenue to Sparkhall Avenue on the sidewalks and curb lanes will take approximately five weeks. After restoration work is completed between Danforth Avenue and Sparkhall Avenue, our contractor will be finished with work in this area for the duration of the project. Watermain connections and additional restoration will continue in the south end of the work zone closer to Gerrard St until mid-June. All other City projects that were previous noted in construction updates has been completed with the exception of ongoing TTC work at Castle Frank Subway Station.
