All dogs and cats living in Toronto must be licensed with Toronto Animal Services and wear the City-issued tag. Licences can also be purchased or renewed online.

### The money received for pet licensing allows us to:

### Do you know?

- Failure to license a dog or cat every year may result in a \$240 ticket. If you are taken to court, the maximum penalty is a \$5,000 fine.
- Toronto Animal Services accepts donations to support programs such as Spay/Neuter, Extended Veterinary Care, Shelter Enhancements or Pet Adoption, Socialization and Enrichment programs. When you donate to Toronto Animal Services, 100% of your donation is used to directly benefit the animals. Your support means so much to animals right in your own community.
