## Basement Flooding Protection Program Sanitary and Storm Sewer Upgrades and Road Resurfacing on Wright Avenue

**Estimated Start Date:  
Late-2022/Early-2023**

This notice provides an update on the sewer upgrades and road resurfacing on Wright Avenue.

Basement Flooding construction on Wright Avenue was scheduled to be completed in 2022. However, due to groundwater issues during construction, the work on Wright Avenue has been postponed and will require additional investigation and design before construction can resume. The City will tender the proposed basement flooding work on Wright Avenue under a new contract and the work is planned to start between the end of 2022 and early 2023. Following completion of the underground work, the roadway will be fully resurfaced.

A maintenance crew has temporarily repaired areas creating a safety concern on Wright Avenue.

We know this project has an impact to all residents on Wright Avenue and we remain committed to alleviating basement flooding within your neighbourhood. We apologize for the inconvenience that this construction has caused and thank you for your patience as we complete necessary basement flooding protection work and roadwork.

A Pre-Construction Notice will be issued to Wright Avenue residents at least eight weeks before construction starts.

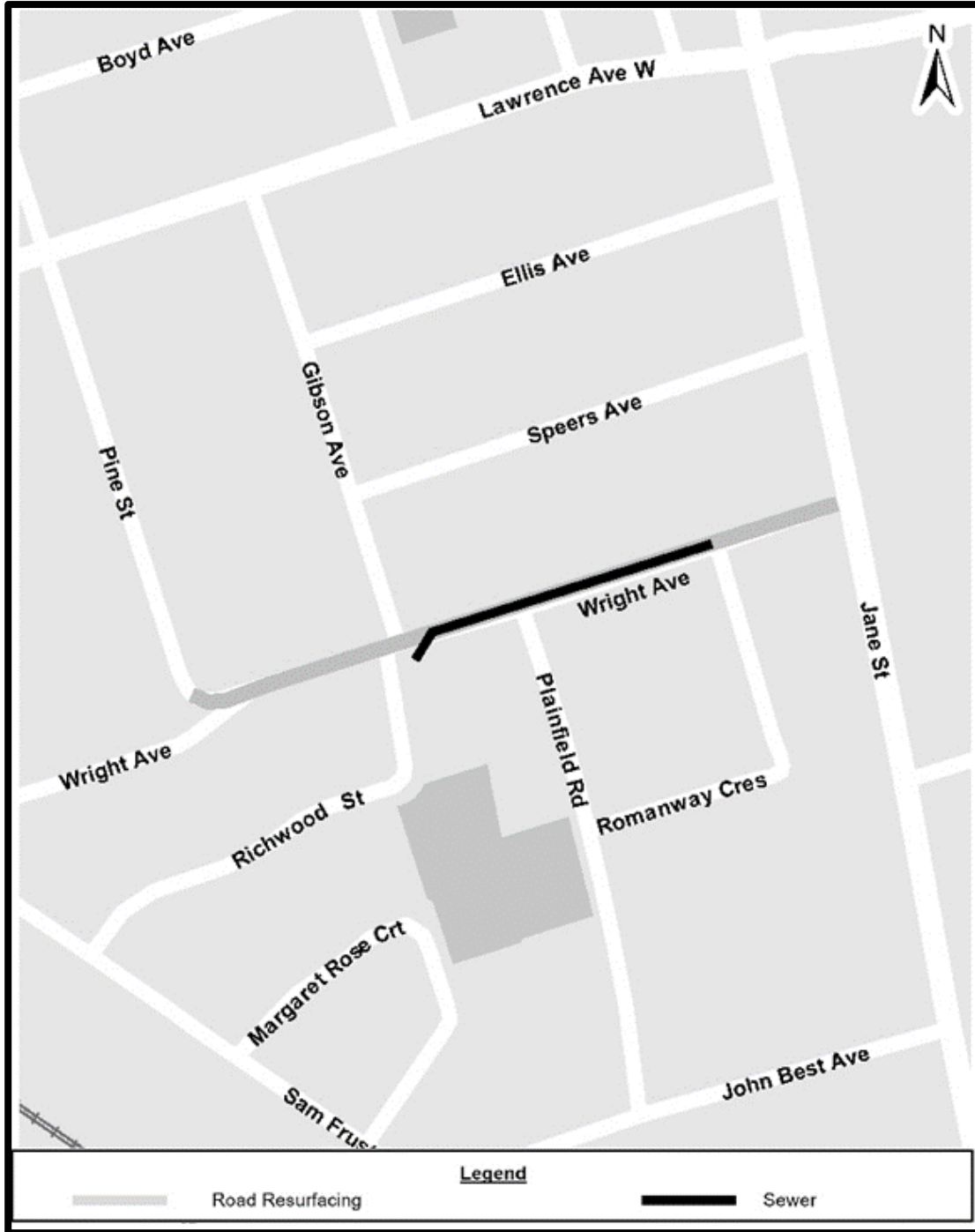
### IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT COVID-19 AND CONSTRUCTION WORK IN TORONTO
