# **INTERSECTION CLOSURE for TTC Track Renewal** at Wellington Street East and Church Street

Contract: 20ECS-TI-20SP


Start Date: July 18, 2022 End Date: August 1, 2022 \*Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.

Construction continues on Wellington Street East with the upcoming replacement of the aging streetcar tracks at the intersection of Wellington Street East and Church Street. In order to complete this work, there will be a full closure of the intersection at Wellington Street East and Church Street starting Monday, July 18 until Monday, August 1.

## WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION



Work Hours: Work will take place from 7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Monday to Friday, and from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturdays or Sundays as required.

Periods of around-the-clock work during rail installation by TTC is required to preserve the integrity and quality of new rail and concrete and support the daytime work. Overnight rail work by TTC may consist of moving new rail into position, rail installation and rail welding / grinding.



**Traffic Management**: Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.

**During Intersection Closure:** 

- West bound traffic on Front Street East will be closed at Jarvis Street to Yonge Street
- LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY will be permitted past Jarvis Street on Front Street
- ONLY RIGHT TURNS PERMITTED AT CHURCH STREET FOR LOACAL TRAFFIC ONLY
- East bound traffic on Front Street East will be maintained.
- Southbound traffic on Church Street will be closed at King Street East

Road and Sidewalk Access: In order to complete the work in a safe manner. there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.



**Driveway Access:** The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.



Parking: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222. Affected properties will get additional parking information. There will be NO PARKING on Wellington Street East during construction. There will be times when on street parking on Front Street East near Market Street will be restricted due to ongoing construction activities.



Accessible Accommodation: The City's contractor must ensure safe and accessible walkways and entryways are maintained for everyone during construction. Any temporary access disruptions will be communicated as soon as possible. If you experience a disruption, have a specific access need or related accommodation request, please contact us at the information below.



TTC Service: During the full closure of the Front Street/Church Street intersection, there will be some changes to the 121 Esplanade-River bus service. Visit ttc.ca for more details.
