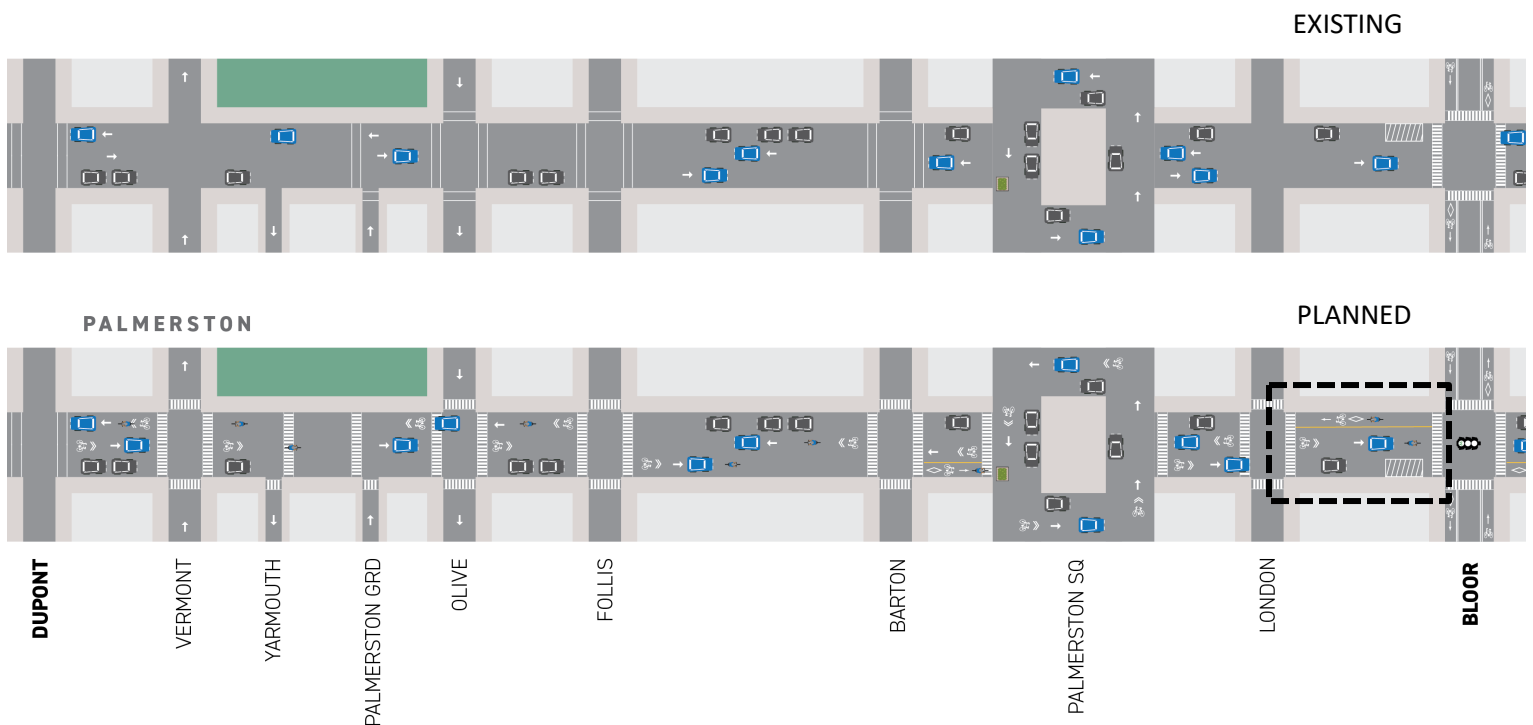
Installation of Road Safety Improvements and Bikeways on Palmerston Avenue, London Street to Bloor Street

Start Date: July 6, 2022

*Rain date July 7, 2022

The City of Toronto is preparing to install contra-flow bike lanes, protected cycle tracks and other safety improvements including wayfinding markings on Palmerston Avenue, Palmerston Square, Palmerston Boulevard and Tecumseth Street from Dupont Street to Niagara Street, and on Lennox Street from Palmerston Avenue to Markham Street. The project was originally approved by the Infrastructure and Environment Committee in December 2021.

The City is currently installing the Dupont Street to Bloor Street segment, including a contra-flow bike lane, northbound on the east side of Palmerston Avenue from London Street to Bloor Street.



Please relocate your vehicle from this section of Palmerston Avenue (London Street to Bloor Street) prior to 9:00 p.m. today, Wednesday July 6th, in order to facilitate this work for 24 hours.

During installation, the City's contractors will complete the following work:

- Remove existing pavement markings;
- Install applicable pavement markings; and,
- Install new signage, as required.



Parking and Loading: Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for installation equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects installation, it will be relocated to a nearby location with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at 416-808-2222. Changes to the parking by-laws will be signed.
