Installation of Road Safety Improvements and Bikeways on Tecumseth Street

Start Date: July 17, *Rain date July 18, 2022 (weather permitting)

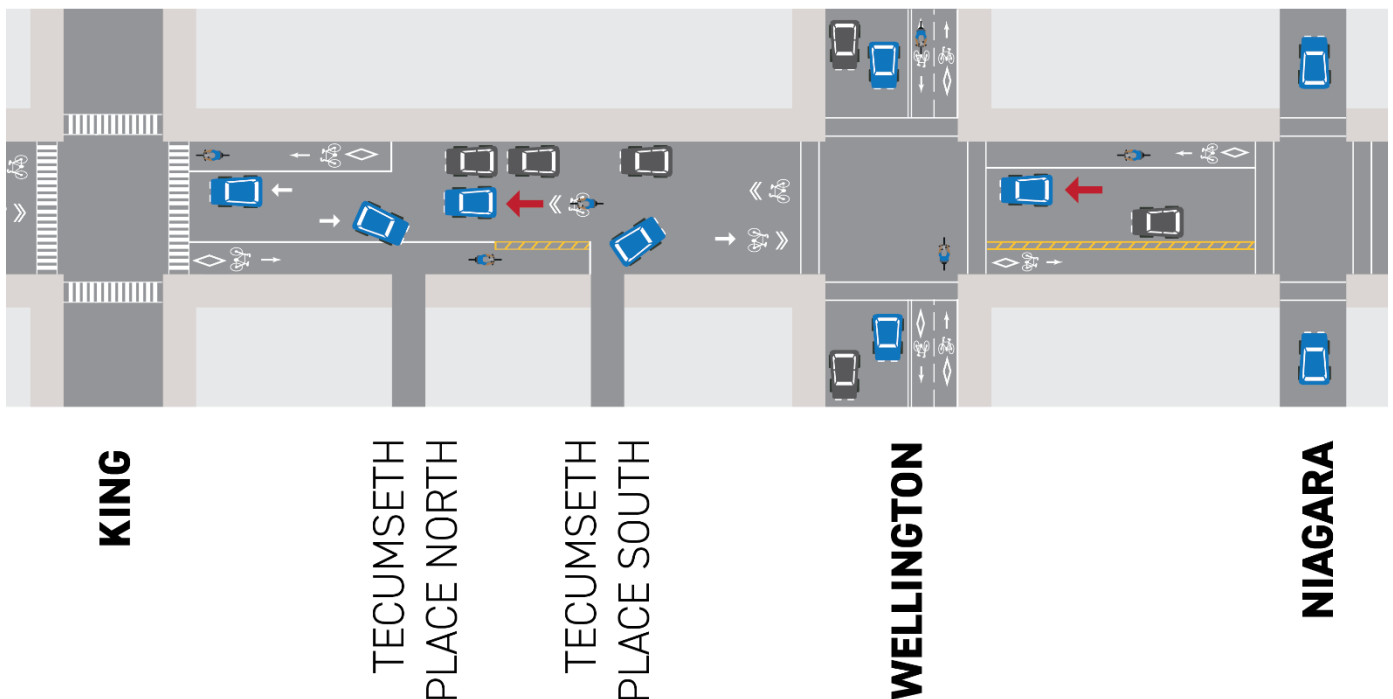
The City of Toronto is preparing to install contra-flow bike lanes, protected cycle tracks and other safety improvements including wayfinding markings on Palmerston Avenue, Palmerston Square, Palmerston Boulevard and Tecumseth Street from Dupont Street to Niagara Street. The project was approved by the Infrastructure and Environment Committee in December 2021.

The City is planning to install the King St W to Niagara St blocks on Tecumseth St beginning at 9:00 p.m. on July 17.

During installation, the City’s contractors will complete the following work:

- Remove existing pavement markings;
- Install applicable pavement markings to add bike lanes between King St W and Tecumseth Place North; convert the two-way between Tecumseth Place North and Tecumseth Place South to a one-way northbound for vehicles and add a contra-flow cycle track (protected bike lane) on the west side; convert the two-way between Wellington and Niagara to a one-way northbound for vehicles, add a contra-flow cycle track (protected bike lane) on the west side, plus parking and add a bike lane on the east side; and,
- Install new signage, as required.

Please do not park between Wellington St and Niagara St after 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, July 17 (rain date July 18) in order to facilitate this work for 24 hours.



Parking and Loading: During the installation, please do not park on either side of the street between Wellington St W and Niagara St. Please park as usual between King St W and Wellington St W. Parking in the active work zone is not permitted due to space requirements for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects installation, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner. If your vehicle is moved, please contact parking control for its location at **416-808-2222**.
