
Work on this project is currently behind schedule. This delay was caused by unforeseen utility conflicts and labour disruptions. The City's contractor is working diligently to complete the remainder of the project.

WORK STATUS TO DATE

To date, the following work has been completed:

- Rehabilitated the north side of the bridge over the Don River, including reconstruction of the concrete deck, sidewalk and parapet walls with railings; replacement of bridge bearings and asphalt surface with bridge waterproofing; and patch repair of piers, abutments and wingwalls
- Road reconstruction between Craigmont Drive and Leslie Street, including substandard water service replacements, cycle track construction and intersection safety modifications from Pineway Boulevard, asphalt surface and concrete sidewalk improvements

REMAINING WORK

In the coming months, the City's contractor will be completing the following work:

- Rehabilitation of the south side of the bridge over the Don River
- Road reconstruction between Bayview Avenue and the bridge over the Don River
