- 1. Estate of George Orfanakos** (Report No. 7744)  
Evangelos Andy Orfanakos, Estate Trustee  
Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-5131184 and V02-5131176;  
Taxicab Plate Nos. 607 and 1561

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the request by the Estate of George Orfanakos for an extension of Taxicab Owner's Licence Nos. V02-5131184 and V02-5131176; Taxicab Plate Nos. 607 and 1561 to remain in the Estate of George Orfanakos until January 30, 2023.

- 2. Eduardo Steve Ventura** (Report No. 7741)  
Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. C208500)

**DECISION:**

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution signed on August 18, 2022, as follows:

"Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled;
- (2) Upon being renewed, the Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Eduardo Steve Ventura is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Eduardo Steve Ventura and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Eduardo Steve Ventura's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (3) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Eduardo Steve Ventura or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7741 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing.”
