## ROAD RECONSTRUCTION at Front Street East and Church Street

**Contract: 20ECS-TI-20SP**

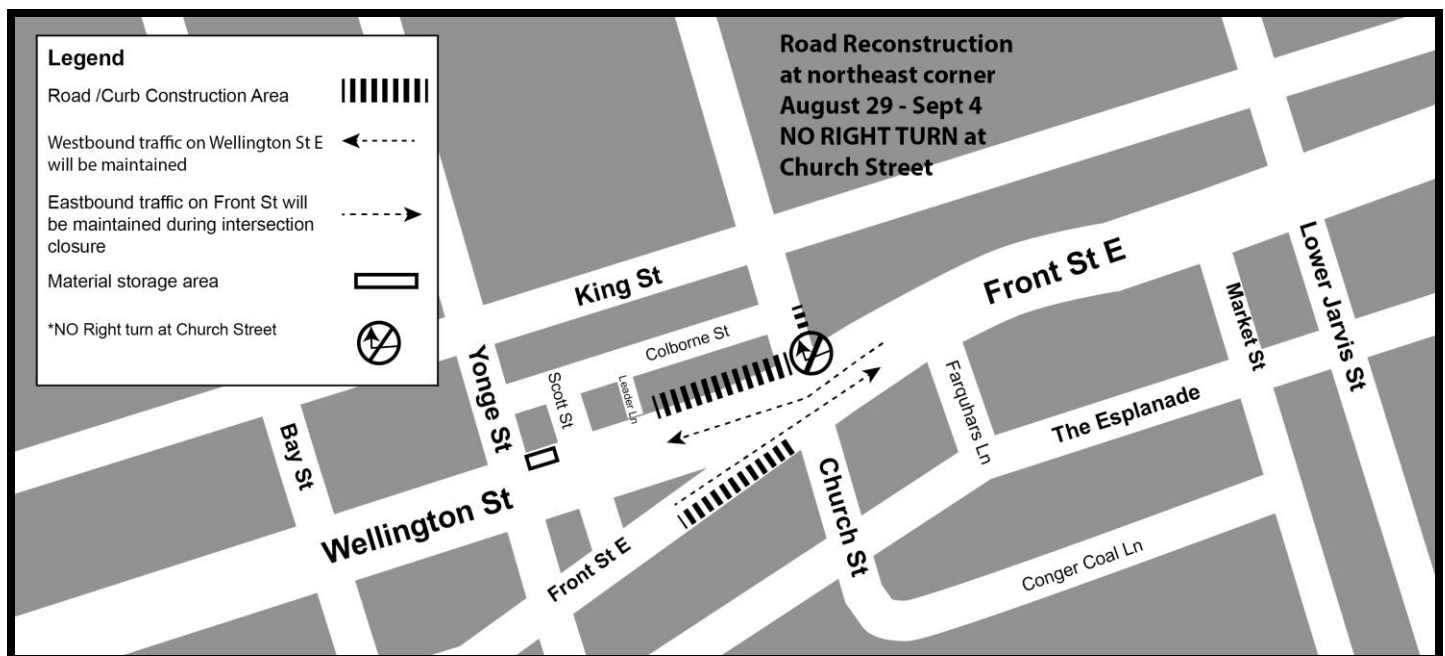
**Start Date: August 29, 2022 End Date: September 4, 2022**

*\*Timelines are subject to change and future notice will be provided.*

The City of Toronto will be reconstructing the northeast corner of the Wellington Street East and Church Street intersection. In order to complete this work, the north curb lane on Front Street will be closed, restricting right turns from westbound Front Street to northbound Church Street.

The right turn restriction will start on **Monday August 29 until Sunday September 4**. Construction material will be stored in the north curb lane on Wellington Street East from west of Yonge Street up to the loading dock.

### WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

	<p><b>Work Hours:</b> Work will take place from <b>7 a.m. to 11 p.m., Monday to Friday</b>, and from <b>7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on Saturdays or Sundays</b> as required.</p>
	<p><b>Traffic Management:</b> Efforts have been made to manage traffic in the area for the safety of workers, road users and residents. Road users should expect delays and increased traffic on nearby main and side streets.</p> <p>During road reconstruction :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>NO RIGHT TURNS PERMITTED AT CHURCH STREET FROM FRONT STREET</b></li> <li>Westbound traffic on Wellington Street East will be maintained</li> <li>Eastbound traffic on Front Street East will be maintained</li> <li>Northbound traffic on Church St will be maintained in one lane</li> <li>Left turns from Front Street East to Church Street northbound will be maintained</li> </ul>
	<p><b>Road and Sidewalk Access:</b> In order to complete the work in a safe manner, there will be road and sidewalk restrictions within the work zone. Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.</p>



	<p><b>Driveway Access:</b> The contractor will notify you of any temporary restrictions to your driveway access. If your property has two entrances, one entrance will be kept open at all times.</p>
	<p><b>Parking:</b> Parking in the active work zone is not permitted as space is needed for construction equipment and materials. If your parked vehicle affects construction work, it will be relocated with no charge to the owner</p>
	<p><b>TTC Service:</b> During this closure, 121 Esplanade-River bus service will continue to divert.  <b>121 Esplanade-River</b>  <b>Westbound:</b> West The Esplanade, North Church Street, West King Street East/King Street West, South Bay Street, East Front Street West  <b>Eastbound:</b> East Front Street West/Front Street East, South Scott Street, East The Esplanade          Visit <a href="http://ttc.ca">ttc.ca</a> for more details.</p>
