DECISION:

The Tribunal issued the following order:

In the matter of Baldev Singh, Report No. 7330, Applicant for a Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence, Application No. B948710, neither Mr. Singh nor his representative, Paul Mitchell, appeared at the scheduled time of 9:30 a.m.

Mr. Mitchell appeared at 10:00 a.m. after receiving a telephone call from Tribunal staff and indicated that he had not received notice of today's hearing because of problems with his technology. Mr. Mitchell did appear at the last hearing date, September 15, 2022, when this matter was adjourned on consent to today's date.

Mr. Singh is the applicant for a licence in this matter. The Tribunal Chair therefore agreed with Mr. Cornett that the next hearing date should be peremptory to Mr. Singh.
