PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE Toronto Local Appeal Body's PROCEDURAL BY-LAW 1-2017

Summary

The Toronto Local Appeal Body will consider the following revisions to its Procedural By-law 1-2017 to facilitate undertaking continuous service improvement initiatives to enhance its operation as an efficient and effective independent, quasi-judicial tribunal.

- a) Subcommittee addition of a definition of 'Subcommittee' in Section 1 of Procedural By-law 1-2017
 "Subcommittee A committee composed of at least two sitting Members of the Toronto Local Appeal Body."
- b) Subcommittee Meeting addition of a definition of "Subcommittee Meeting" in Section 1 of Procedural By-law 1-2017 "Subcommittee Meeting A gathering of Subcommittee Members."
- c) The addition of Section 30 to Procedural By-law 1-2017 as follows: "The Members may, by Motion, establish Subcommittees to discuss items of interest to the TLAB. The Members of a Subcommittee may, on notice to each Member of the Subcommittee, schedule a meeting of a Subcommittee."
- d) A revision of Section 12(3) of Procedural By-law 1-2017 as follows: 'Members participating in the Business Meeting electronically are counted towards quorum'.
- e) The deletion of Section 29(2) (Voting Requirements and Notice) of Procedural By-law 1-2017.
