1. Mohamed Akil Bacchus (Report No. 7213)

Applicant for the Renewal of Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence No. D01-4692656 AND

Holder of Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3129389, Plate No. A381

DECISION:

Mr. Bacchus requested an adjournment of this matter in advance of today's hearing. The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment, on consent, to November 10, 2022 at 9:30 a.m.

The Tribunal further ordered the continuation of the interim suspension previously placed on Mr. Bacchus' Vehicle-For-Hire Driver's Licence at the November 14, 2019 Tribunal Hearing, until such time the Tribunal orders otherwise.

Mr. Bacchus' Taxicab Owner's Licence No. V02-3129389 continues to be valid.

2. Francesco Caruso (Report No. 7755)

Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. C219252)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

"Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions:

(1) All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the licence may be cancelled:

- (2) Upon issuance the Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be suspended for fourteen (14) consecutive days;
- (3) The Tow Truck Driver's Licence will be placed on probation for a period of two (2) years. Francesco Caruso is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any driving, criminal, and by-law charges and convictions against Francesco Caruso and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Francesco Caruso's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;
- (4) Prior to the next two (2) renewals of the licence, Francesco Caruso must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at his own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of his Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (5) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Francesco Caruso or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and report no. 7755 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."

The Tribunal further ordered Mr. Caruso must sign the Proposed Resolution and return it to Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal Hearing, on consent.
