Introduction

All dates and requirements are subject to change. Candidates that are currently base hospital certified with an Ontario Municipal Service may not be required to complete Stage 1.

You will be receiving emails from addresses using the following domains: @toronto.ca and @eventbrite.com It is suggested that you favorite these domains and keywords to minimize the likelihood of filtering to your spam or junk folders.

Candidates will receive an email from <u>paramedic.careers@toronto.ca</u> following every *successful* stage. This email will indicate which documentation to submit for the upcoming stage. These emails may also invite you to schedule an appointment for your next testing stage.

Recruitment Stages

Conditional employment offers are expected to occur on multiple dates starting in February and continuing into March. We anticipate multiple onboarding for 2023 that are tentatively scheduled to commence on March 20th, May 1st, June 12th and September 6th. The onboarding process consists of online courses, in-class training and a 6-week field mentorship portion.
