## **Outbreak Preparedness: Supplies and Resources Quest!**

**Introduction:** It is very important that we know where to access outbreak related supplies and who to contact if we identify that supplies and resources are getting low. This supplies and resources hunt activity will help us become familiar with our facility surroundings and where to expeditiously find resources. This way, all staff will be ready to implement additional outbreak precautions or testing required in the event of an outbreak. Let's get prepared!
