## City Infrastructure Work in The Kingsway and Dundas Street West Area

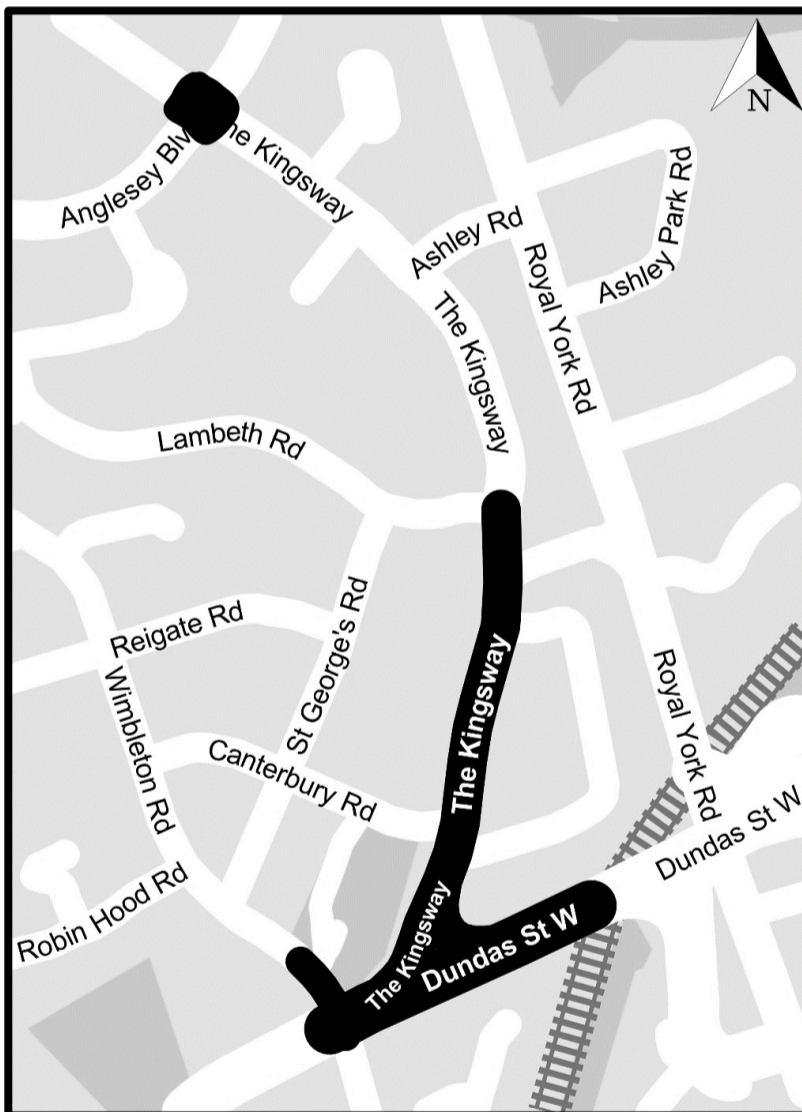
**Start Date: February 23, 2022 End Date: December 16, 2022**

Since infrastructure improvements in The Kingsway and Dundas Street West area commenced in February City contractors have been able to complete replacing substandard water services on The Kingsway. Remaining work includes road reconstruction on The Kingsway from Dundas Street West to Lambeth Road and intersection design changes at The Kingsway and Dundas Street West and at Anglesey Boulevard to improve road safety and pedestrian accessibility.

Additional intersection modifications will also be undertaken at Wimbleton Road and Dundas Street West. Road reconstruction work will take place before December 16, 2022 weather permitting. Please see Current Work Status below for all completed and remaining work.

#### Completed Works

- Installation of substandard water services on The Kingsway

#### Outstanding Works

#### Road reconstruction: The Kingsway from Dundas Street West to Lambeth Road

October 4, 16, 2022, to November, 2022\*

Crews will:

- Remove the asphalt surface and concrete road base

- Remove the west side ditch and construct a new sidewalk, curbs and stormwater catch basins on the west side
- Regrade the east side ditch
- Replace and widen the sidewalk on the east side, to meet City standards for *November, 2022\**
- Intersection safety improvements
- Curb radii reduction
- Curb extensions
- Road reconstruction and road resurfacing
- Green infrastructure in northeast corner
- New bus pad at northeast corner
