The City of Toronto's track replacement and streetscaping improvement work on Wellington Street East is progressing well. This notice is to provide an update on the intersection work at Wellington Street and Yonge Street. Overnight work will take place on three nights starting on Friday December 9th at 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., Saturday December 10th 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. and Sunday December 11th from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. The City contractor will commence overnight underground electrical work and associated pavement repairs at the northwest corner of the intersection at Wellington Street and Yonge Street.

Construction work from December 9th to the December 11th will only take place at night, there will be no day time construction activity. Work will start at 6:00 p.m. and end the following morning at 7:00 a.m. Sunday overnight work will end on Monday morning at 7:00 a.m. When this overnight work is complete, regular work hours will resume. Your patience and understanding is appreciated during this overnight work.
