





HOUSEHOLD **HAZARDOUS** WASTE



Cleaning, barbecuing or painting your home?

These activities can result in household hazardous waste, which requires special handling. Improper disposal of household hazardous waste can harm workers and cause fires and explosions in collection trucks and at waste management facilities. Please DO NOT put

household hazardous waste in the Garbage Bin, Blue Bin (recycling). Green Bin (organics) or pour it down the drain, toilet or sewers.



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE INCLUDES:

- · Paint, stains, turpentine, glue
- Household cleaning products. drain cleaners, bleach
- Automotive fuels, oils and fluids
- Propane and helium tanks/cylinders

- Non-empty aerosol cans
- Batteries
- Syringes, medical sharps, medication
- Pesticides and garden products
- · Compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs), tubes

DISPOSAL INSTRUCTIONS

You can dispose of your household hazardous waste by:

- Visiting a Drop-Off Depot (see pages 6 & 7)
- Bringing it to a Community Environment Day (learn more at toronto.ca/environment days)
- Arranging a free Toxic Taxi pickup of 10 to 50 L/kg of household hazardous waste. Visit toronto.ca/311 or contact 311 to request a pickup. In an apartment or condo building, pickup needs to be arranged by building staff

UPGRADING ELECTRONICS?

Electronic waste should never be put in the Blue Bin (recycling). Electronic waste is collected separately at the curb on garbage day or can be brought to a

Drop-Off Depot (see pages 6 & 7) or a Community Environment Day. Residents of apartments/ condos should take electronics to their building's designated drop-off area.

SMALL ITEMS such as cell phones, keyboards and computer cables should be put out at the curb in a clear plastic bag or cardboard box. If possible, put more than one item out at a time.

LARGE ITEMS such as computer monitors and televisions, can be put on the ground. Remember to protect your privacy and clear all personal information from electronics prior to collection, drop-off or donation.

REDUCE YOUR WASTE

The City manages almost 900,000 tonnes of waste each year – that's equivalent to the weight of about 8,500 blue whales. This requires money, energy and resources and takes up limited landfill space. The less waste produced, the less there is to manage and the less the environmental impact.

TRY THESE SIMPLE WAYS TO REDUCE YOUR WASTE:



SWAP disposable items, such as bags, coffee cups, water bottles and paper towels, for reusable ones.



REFUSE single-use items you don't need such as takeout cutlery and napkins, receipts you won't keep and extra packaging.



BORROW items from a lending library, **SWAP** or **SHARE** items with friends or neighbours and **RENT** items for special events instead of buying new.



REPAIR AND REPURPOSE items to extend their life.



CUT FOOD WASTE as growing, manufacturing, transporting and disposing of food can all create greenhouse gas emissions, which contribute to climate change. Reduce your food waste by planning your meals, buying only what you need, storing food correctly and making the most of leftovers.
