Community Update January 2023 – Road Closure Notice

Please be advised that from the week of January 9 up to the week of January 23, 2023 a section of Glamorgan Avenue at Dundalk Drive will be closed for construction activities related to 39 Dundalk Drive. The street will be closed daily from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. and the south sidewalk will be closed to pedestrians. The north sidewalk will remain open to pedestrians.

The closure will not block the driveway entrance and exit for residents of 5 and 6 Glamorgan Avenue. Access to Kennedy Road will be available via Glamorgan Avenue.



Flag persons will be on site during this time to help direct traffic and ensure safety for neighbours and construction crews.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

There are more than 8,000 people experiencing homelessness in Toronto. New supportive and affordable housing is urgently needed to ensure everyone has a safe place to call home. To respond to this need, the City of Toronto is building supportive housing at 39 Dundalk Drive using modular construction. The new building will provide warm, safe homes for approximately 57 people with on-site services that support health and well-being. The new homes will be furnished studio apartments with a bathroom and kitchen. The building will include amenities such as shared laundry, a commercial kitchen, a dining area, a communal area and programming space.
