TORONTO LICENSING TRIBUNAL ELECTRONIC HEARING: January 5, 2023 (9:30 AM) Summary of Decisions E. Montigny

1. Sandeep Singh Dhillon (Report No. 7740) Applicant for a Tow Truck Driver's Licence (Application No. C202971)

DECISION:

Municipal Licensing and Standards requested an adjournment of this matter. The Tribunal approved the request for adjournment to August 17, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., on consent.

2. Corrinne Marie Thompson (Report No. 7761) Applicant for an Entertainer Licence (Application No. C222419)

DECISION:

The Tribunal approved the joint Proposed Resolution, on consent, as follows:

"An Entertainer Licence will be issued, subject to the following conditions;

- All fees, documents and/or any outstanding requirements must be submitted to the satisfaction of Municipal Licensing and Standards within 30 days of the Tribunal hearing, failing which the application may be cancelled;
- (2) Immediately upon being issued, the Entertainer Licence will be placed on probation for a period of <u>Two</u> (2) year(s). Corrinne Marie Thompson is advised that during the probationary period, MLS may make additional checks of any criminal and by-law charges and convictions against Corrinne Marie Thompson and conduct other investigations, as appropriate, to assess Corrinne Marie Thompson's compliance with the requirements of Chapter 545 of the Municipal Code and other applicable laws;

- (3) Prior to each of the next <u>Two</u> (2) renewal(s) of the licence, Corrinne Marie Thompson must provide to Municipal Licensing and Standards, at her own expense, an original up-to-date abstract of her Criminal Record and Judicial Matters Check;
- (4) During the probationary period, if Municipal Licensing and Standards has concerns with any new charges or convictions against Corrinne Marie Thompson or any other concerns with respect to the conduct of the licensee, those matters and Report No. 7761 and any updating material, may be brought back before the Tribunal for a full hearing."
